Coffee, Tea and Desserts (CTD)

Nadia started CTD 4 years ago in the centre of Main City. CTD is a successful café that sells coffee, tea and desserts. Nadia operates as a sole trader. When she opened her café she wanted the business to remain small. Nadia has 3 employees serving customers in the café.

CTD has a reputation for selling high-quality desserts. Nadia has 8 employees making the desserts in the café kitchen. Each worker carries out a task and then passes the part-finished product on to the next employee until the dessert is finished. Nadia knows that CTD's good reputation could be lost if the high quality of her desserts is not maintained. Nadia is considering the best way to continue to produce high-quality desserts in her kitchen.

Nadia uses cost-plus pricing for all the food and drinks CTD sells. She knows promotion is important for CTD as she wants to encourage new customers and create brand loyalty amongst her existing customers. Most of CTD's customers are people working or shopping in the city centre who walk past the café.

Nadia is now planning to expand and open a second café in Main City. Nadia is considering whether to set up a new café or to take over a competitor's café. Nadia is recruiting a café manager for the second café whichever option she chooses. She has three applicants to choose between. Information about these applicants is shown in Appendix 3.
