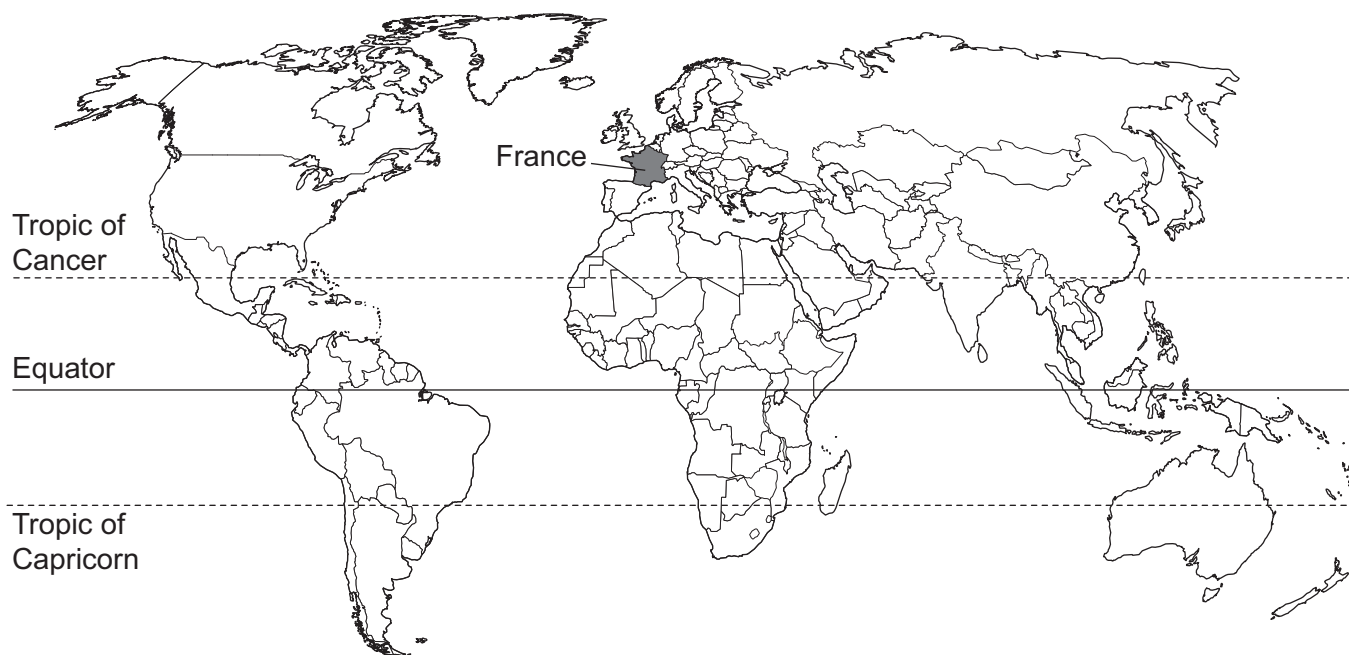




world map showing the location of France

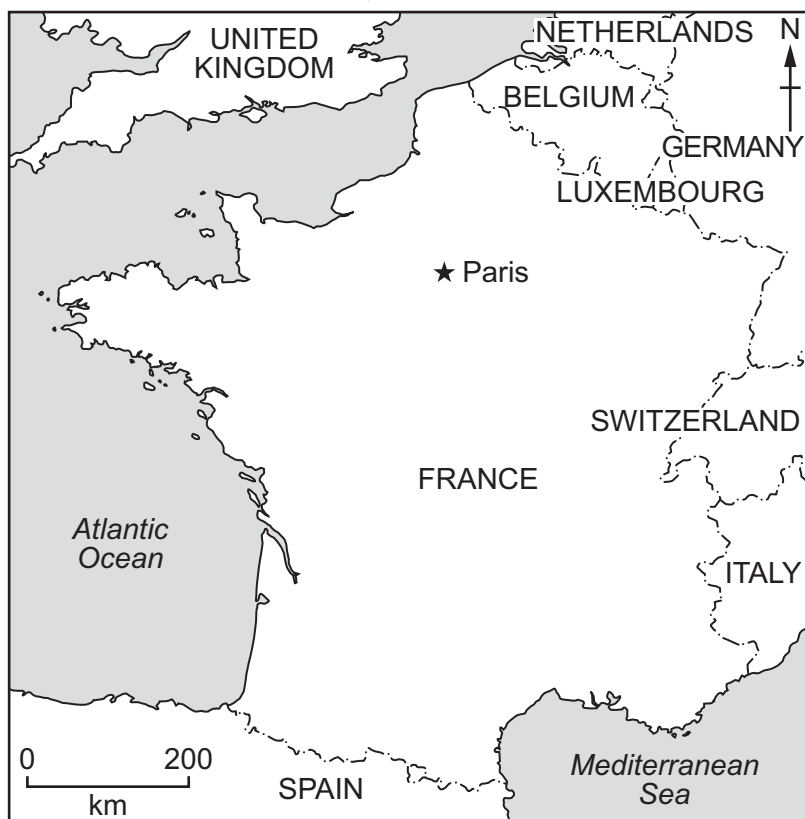

France is a country in Europe. France has reserves of minerals that are extracted and exported. Agriculture is a major industry. Tourism is important for the economy.



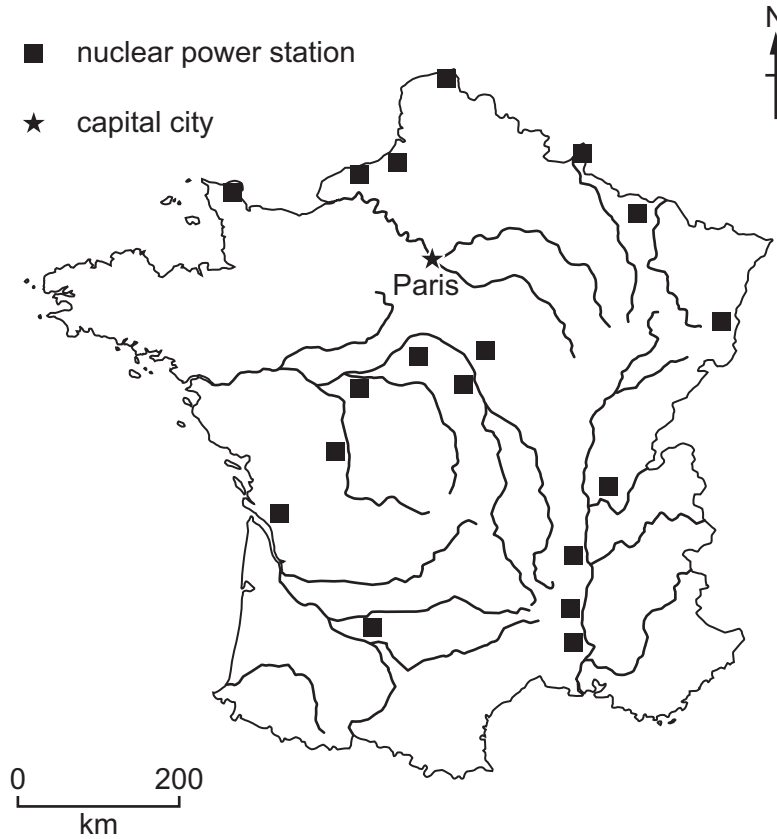

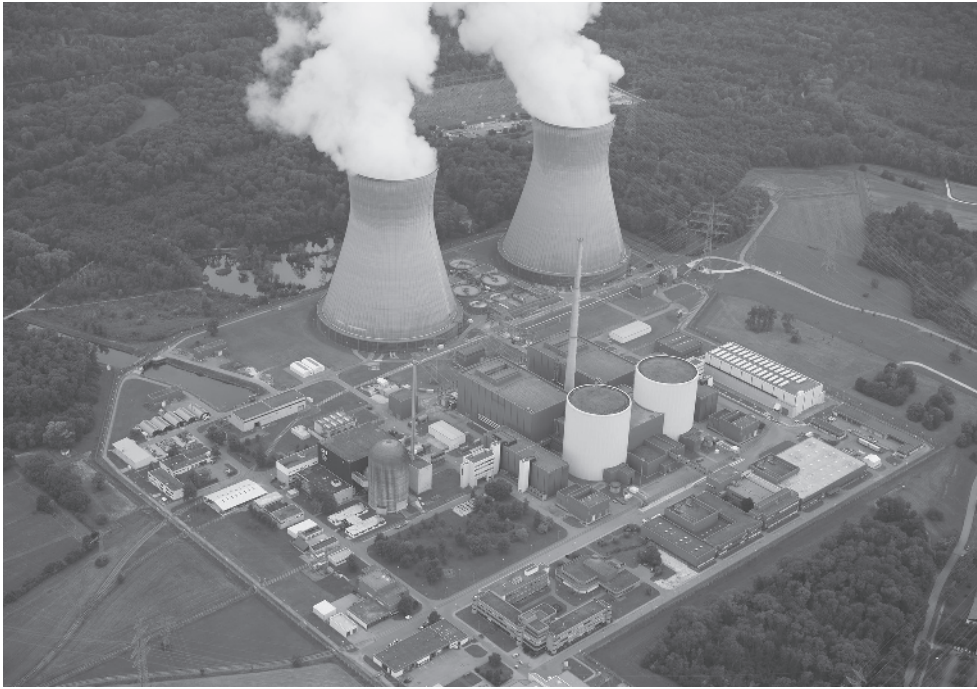

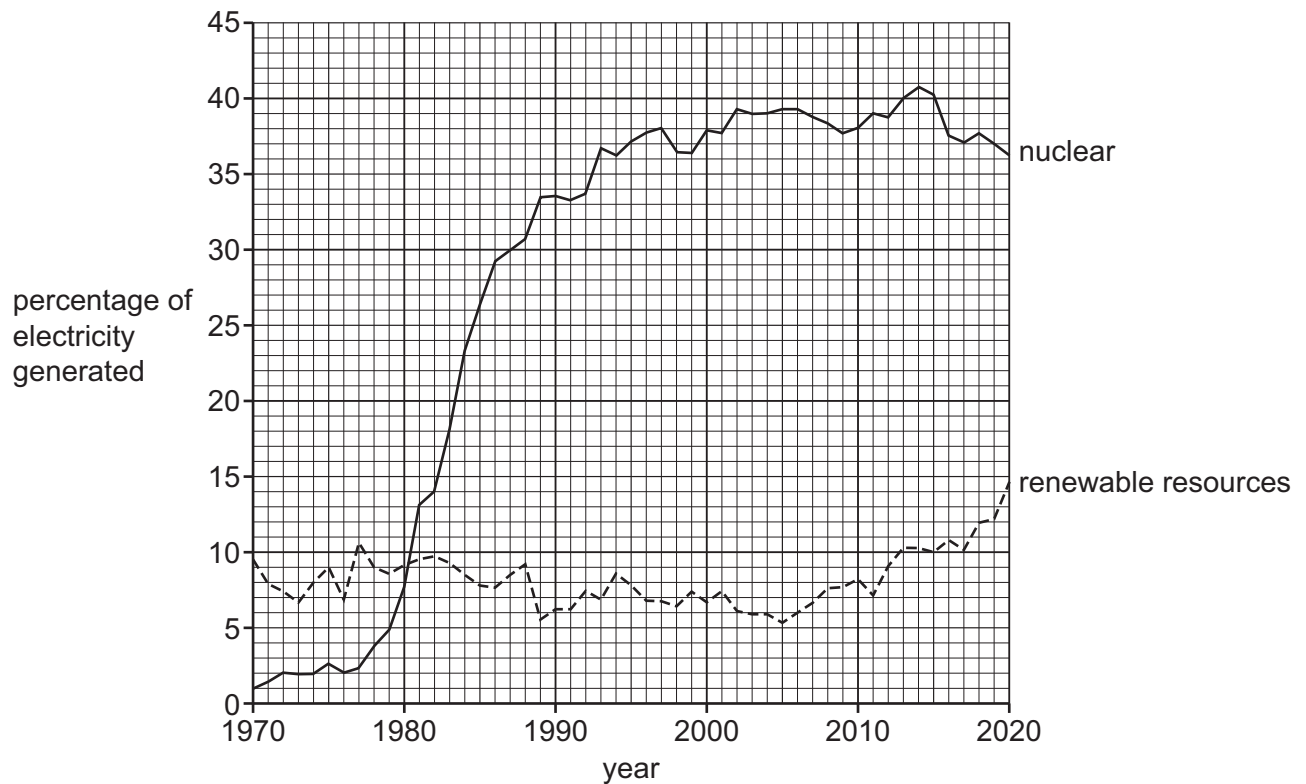

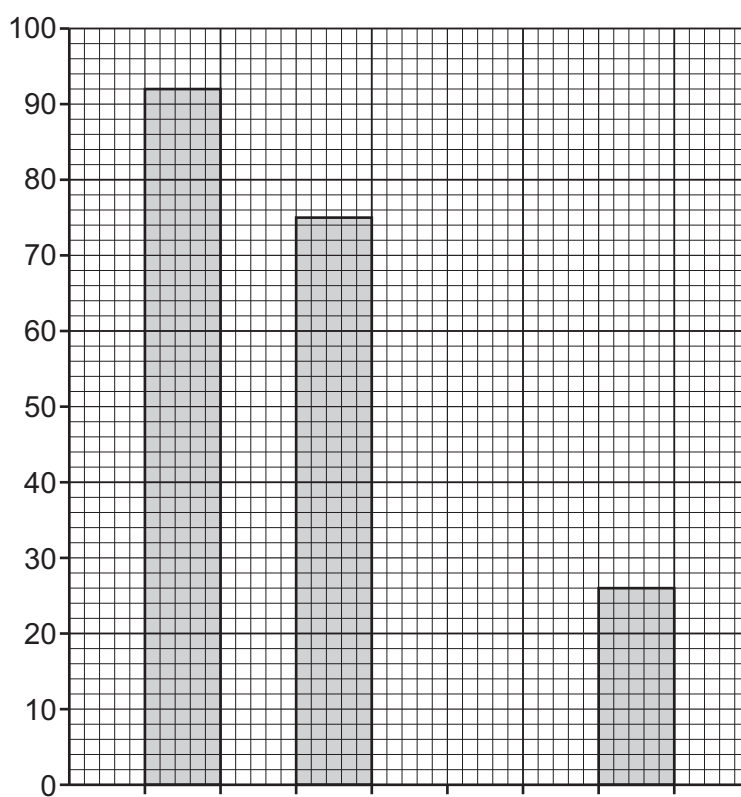

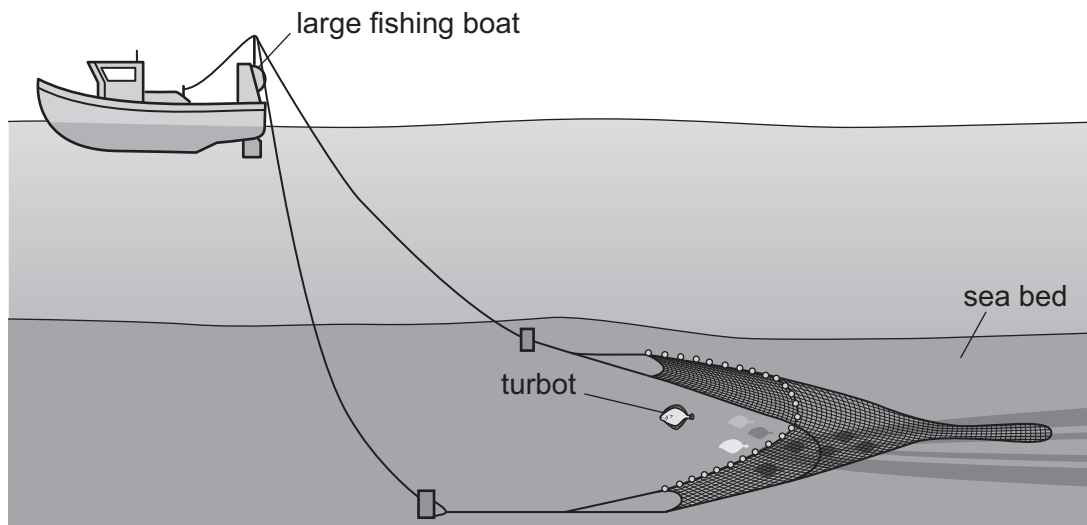

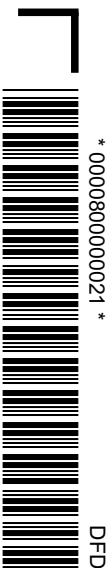

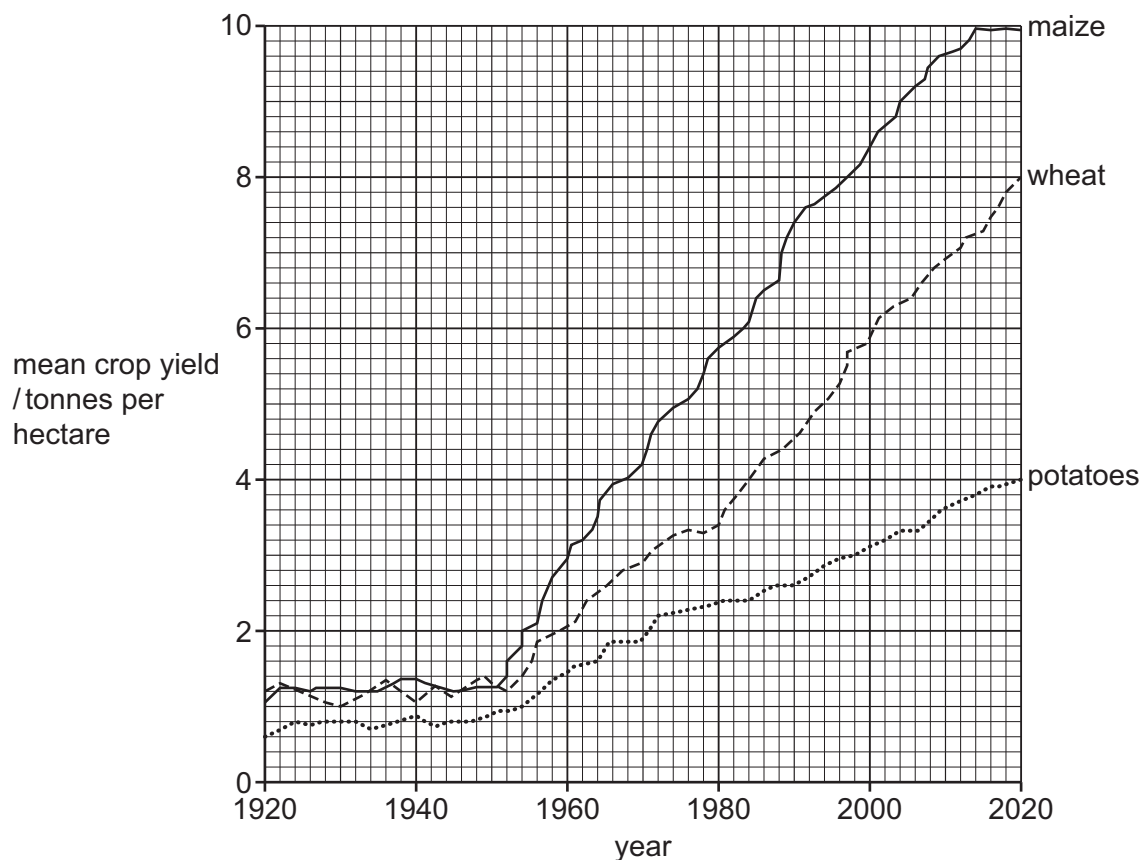
