- 1 Describe the qualifications and training required for lay magistrates. Assess whether they are adequately prepared for their role. [25]

- 3 The use of delegated legislation has both advantages and risks.
Describe the types of delegated legislation. Assess whether the controls on its use are adequate. [25]
- 4 Bella has been arrested on suspicion of committing murder and taken to her local police station.
Explain how Bella should be detained and treated at a police station. Assess whether the law adequately protects her rights in this situation. [25]
- 5 Compare the education and training of barristers and solicitors. Assess whether they are adequately prepared for their roles. [25]
- 6 Explain why Equity was needed when custom and common law had already developed. Assess the continued need for Equity today. [25]

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
