1 Study Documents A and B.

- (a) The author of Document A discusses some reasons why people are protesting in Latin America.

Identify **three** economic reasons for people's anger as given by the author of Document A. [3]

- (b) The author of Document B discusses whether protests work.

Identify **two** groups of protesters named by the author of Document B. [2]

2 Study Document A.

Assess the strengths and weaknesses of the evidence used by the author of Document A to support her argument that people in Latin America are losing faith in democracy.

In your answer, include the impact of the evidence on the author's argument. [15]

3 Study Documents A and B.

The two authors present different arguments and perspectives about protest movements.

Evaluate the arguments of both authors. In your answer, consider their perspectives and include a reasoned judgement about whether one argument is stronger than the other. [25]

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
