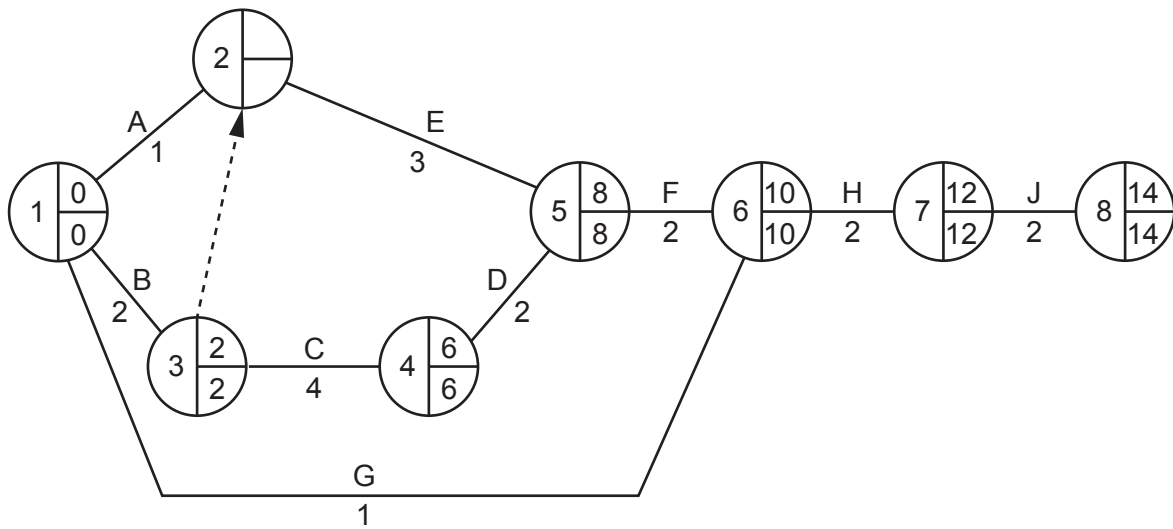


Fig. 1: Network diagram for the installation of new machines
