Describe the features of an appropriate online data entry form for one film which would, where appropriate, allow the user to enter data by clicking the mouse rather than entering text.

- (a)** Give reasons why the current arrangement of computers would not enable Dian to set up a video-conference and explain how he would overcome this problem.

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- (b)** Describe how codecs would be used in the transmission of data within a video-conference.

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(b) Apart from the types of keys used, give **two** reasons why symmetric encryption is preferred in certain situations.

By weighing up the advantages and disadvantages, evaluate the differences between a flat file database and a relational database which would help Sujatmi make her decision as to which to use.

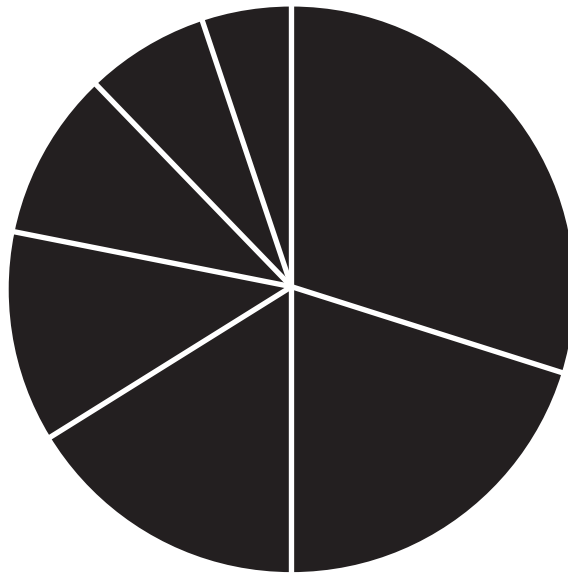
