You work for the Tawara Bus Company and will analyse data collected one day last week showing the time taken by each bus on each stage of the journey between Tawara and Montrazzi. All buses leave Tawara and stop briefly at 12 places before arriving in Montrazzi.

You must use the most efficient method to solve each task. All documents produced must be of a professional standard and suit the business context.

- 1 Open and examine the file **20-Journeys.csv** in a spreadsheet.

Merge cells D1 to AW1.

Format the spreadsheet so that it is consistent throughout and the left side of the spreadsheet looks like this:

2 Insert appropriate formulae and labels in:

- row 18 to calculate the total expected journey time
- row 18 to calculate the total journey time for each bus
- row 19 to calculate the arrival time for each bus
- column AX to count, for each place, the number of times when a bus was later than expected.

For each stage of each journey, use conditional formatting to display the contents of the cell as:

- white text on a red background if this stage took longer than the expected time
- black text on a yellow background if the stage time was the same as the expected time
- dark blue text on a light green background if the stage time was less than the expected time.

Insert a formula in cell D20 to calculate, for all stages of all buses, the percentage of stages when the bus was later than expected. Include an appropriate label for this cell.

Apply appropriate formatting to your spreadsheet.

Place your name, centre number and candidate number in the header of the spreadsheet.

Save your spreadsheet as **Stage_** followed by your centre number_candidate number

e.g. Stage_ZZ999_9999

3 Create a second identical spreadsheet in your workbook.

In this new spreadsheet:

- change the background colour of all cells with a black background to blue
- delete rows 18, 19 and 20
- remove the conditional formatting from all cells.

Save this spreadsheet as **Arrive_** followed by your centre number_candidate number

e.g. Arrive_ZZ999_9999

4 In this new spreadsheet:

- edit the text in the merged cell A4:A16 to say **Expected length of journey to this town**
- place in cell B3 the time 00:00:00
- place in cell B4 a formula to display the expected time taken to reach this town
- use the data stored in your **Stage** spreadsheet to help you replicate this formula for each town
- place replicable formulae in cells D4 to AW16, without changing the structure of the spreadsheet, to display the time that each bus arrived at each town
- for each stage of each journey, use conditional formatting to display the contents of the cell as black text on a light green background for any stage where the bus was on time or early.

Save your spreadsheet.

You will create, for the Tawara Bus Company, a short promotional video clip to try to persuade new customers to use their bus service.

The original video clip was filmed on location in Tawara by TMBvideo.

All video and audio clips produced must be of a professional standard and suit the business context.

5 Open the file **20-HQ.mp4** in video editing software. Set the aspect ratio to 16:9.

Remove from the video clip the:

- sound
- first 12.5 seconds
- end so that only 2 seconds remain.

Change the speed of the video clip (slow it) so that its total duration is 4 seconds.

Save your video clip in **.mp4 format** with a resolution of 854 × 480 and the file name **TBC_** followed by your centre number_candidate number

e.g. TBC_ZZ999_9999

Save it with the file name **TBC1** in a format suitable for importing into your video editing software.

7 Open the file **20-Transport.mp4** in video editing software.

Split the video clip into 3 sections. The first section is between 0 and 3 seconds, the second section is between 3 and 4.5 seconds and the third section is between 4.5 seconds and the end of the video clip. Set the speed of the:

- first section to 1 × speed
- middle section to 1.25 × speed
- last section to 1 × speed.

Save your video clip in **.mp4 format** as **TPT_** followed by your centre number_candidate number

e.g. TPT_ZZ999_9999

All text should be displayed in a consistent sans-serif font.

Time 0 seconds:

Background image **20-Bus.jpg**

Time 2 seconds:

Background image remains with the name of the company placed as a yellow title in the bottom left corner

Time 4 seconds:

The title text and background remain, with the text **Professional & Punctual** added as a subtitle in the bottom right corner

Audio clip **20-TBCaudio.mp3** starts

Time 8 seconds:

All background and text removed

Video clip **TPT_** starts

Time 17 seconds:

Background image **20-NewBus.jpg** cropped to remove the top of the image so that it is 1080 pixels high

Time 21 seconds:

Place image **20-OldBus.jpg**

Time 23 seconds:

Place image **20-Bike.jpg**

Time 25 seconds:

Video clip **TBC_** starts

Time 29 seconds:

Still image **TBC1** displayed as a background until the end of your video.

Display appropriate credits to scroll up the right half of the screen. Include the text **Edited by:** and your name, centre number and candidate number in the credits. [30]

- 9 Export your video clip in **.mp4 format** as **TVideo_** followed by your centre number_candidate number
