Task 1a

The correct answers for the multiple-choice tests are provided in the **Test_Answers.rtf** file.

Question 6
Which of these SQL JOINS selects only the records in both tables?

The file **Test_102_Student_Responses.csv** contains the students' responses to test 102.

Use a spreadsheet to record the mark for each question for every student who took test 102 and to calculate their total mark for the test.

Save your work as **Test_102_** followed by your centre number_candidate number
e.g. Test_102_ZZ999_9999

Create a database with the same name as the spreadsheet.

Use this database to present the class results when a user enters the name of a class.

Task 1b

You are required to mail merge notifications of results to students in Class FE1. You will need to amend your spreadsheet to complete this task.

In addition to the *Student_ID*, *Name*, *Class* and *Score*, each notification letter must display text informing students whether their result is a pass or whether they need to resit the test or retake the course.

Each letter must also display a list of the question numbers that the student answered incorrectly.

Open the **Notifications_Template** file to see how the information must be displayed.

To include the conditional information, follow these rules:

For students who scored 13 or more marks display the text:

This is a Pass mark.

For students who scored 10, 11 or 12 marks display the text:

Please arrange to resit the test.

For students who scored less than 10 marks display the text:

You will need to retake the course.

For students who answered all the questions correctly display the following text:

You answered all the questions correctly.

For students who did not answer all the questions correctly display the following text:

You answered the following questions incorrectly:

followed by a list of the question numbers the student answered incorrectly.

Save the merge document as **NotificationsMergeDoc_102_** followed by your centre number_candidate number

e.g. Notification_Letters_102_ZZ999_9999

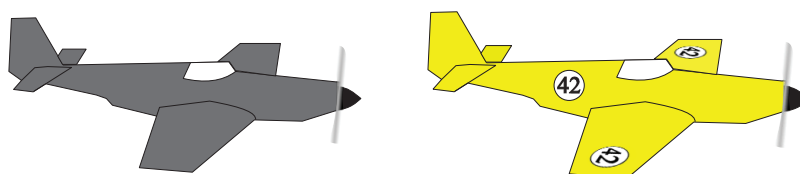

The new aeroplane should be coloured pure yellow as shown.

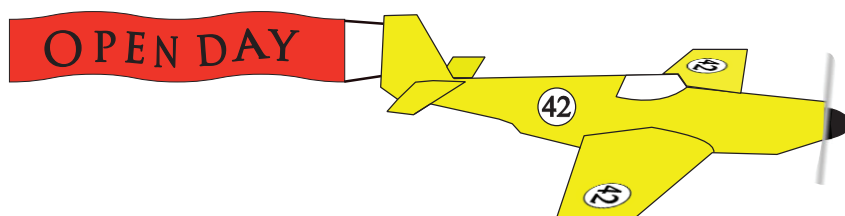
Add the designs to the body and the wings as shown.

Add a ribbon streamer to the tail of the *VPlane* image as shown.



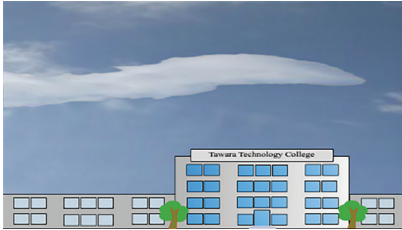
Save the image in **.svg** format as **VPlanePlus_** followed by your centre number_candidate number

e.g. VPlanePlus_ZZ999_9999

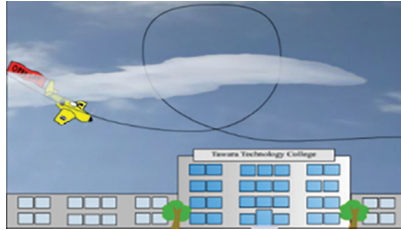

Task 3

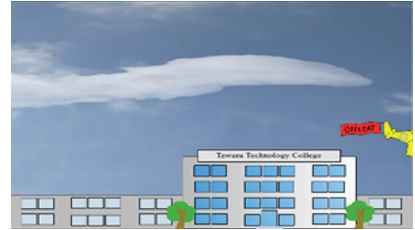
In an animation application set a stage/frame size to 1280px wide by 720px high.



Use the **Sky.png**, **Cloud.png** and **TTC.svg** image files to create the background as shown.



Use your *VPlanePlus* image to create an animation of the aeroplane.



The aeroplane must take 6 seconds to enter from the left, follow the looped path and leave the frame on the right.

Note:

- the size of the *VPlanePlus* image must match the size shown in this example
- the path of the aeroplane is behind the cloud image
- the cloud is partially transparent.



1 second after the aeroplane has left the frame it must reappear from the right and take 6 seconds to follow the new path shown and leave the frame. After 1 second the animation must restart.

Save the animation as an animated **.gif** file named **OpenDay_** followed by your centre number_

candidate number

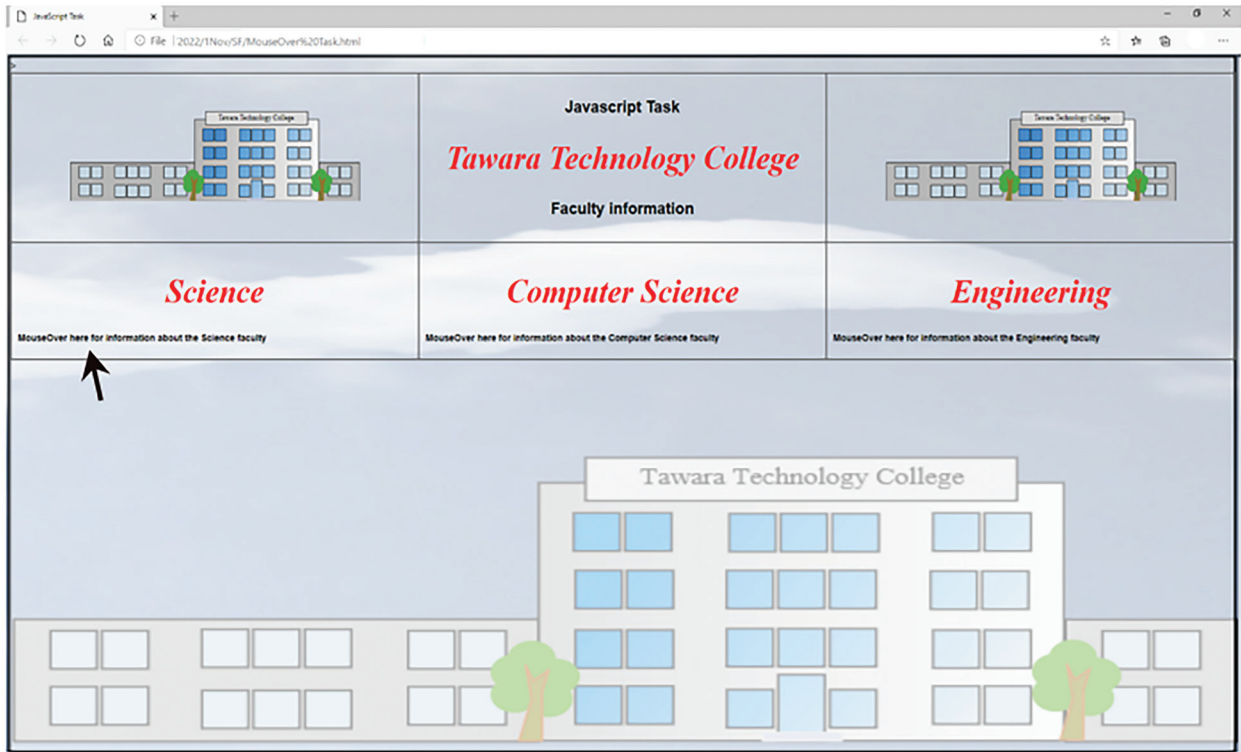

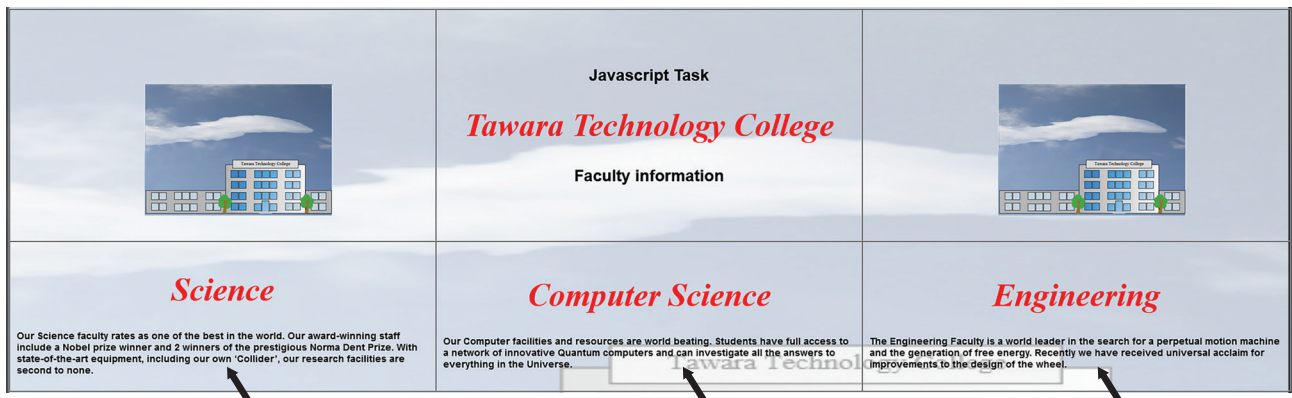
Task 4
