Migration out of the UK and migration into the UK, by sex and age group, in 2018

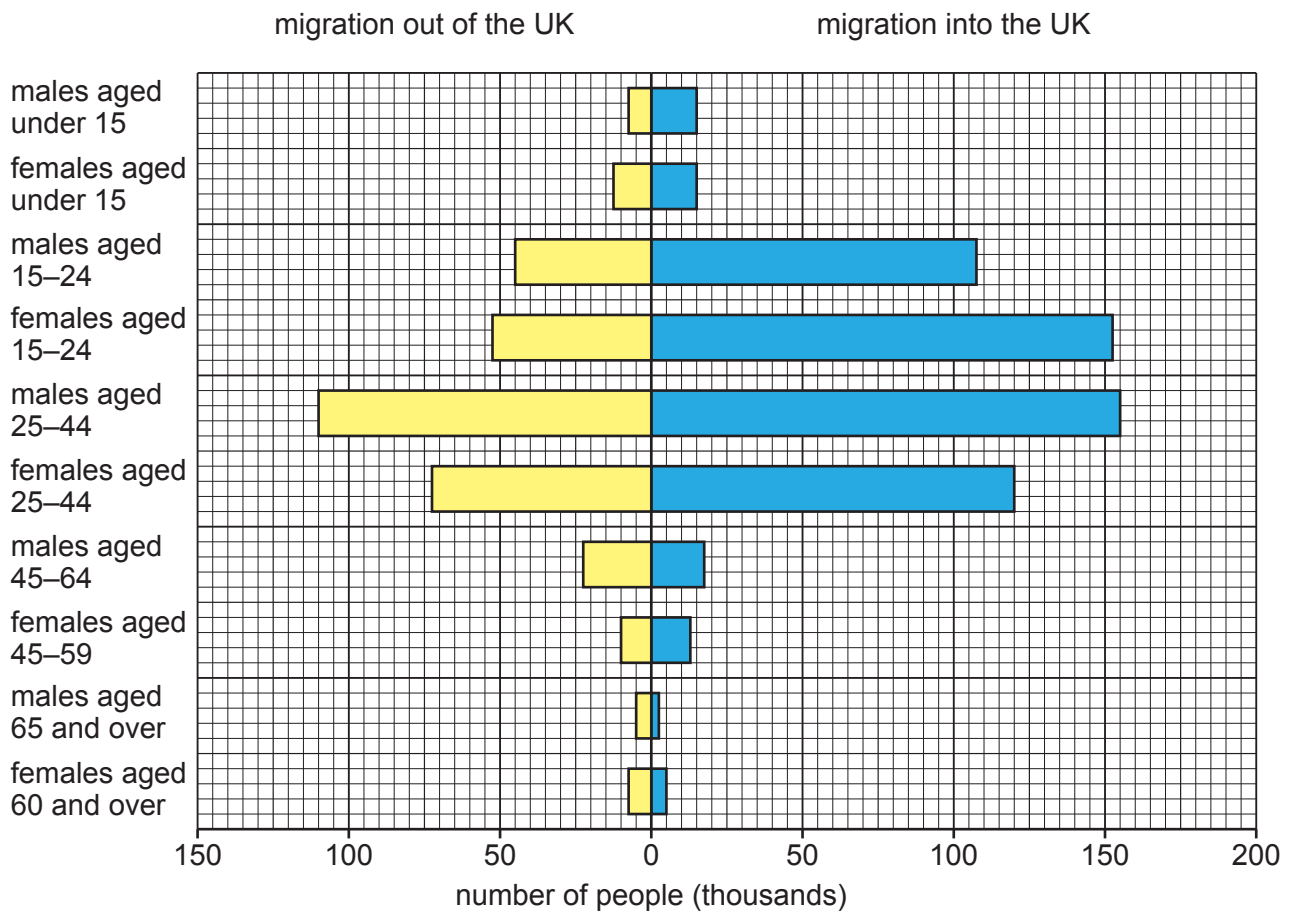
