A typical profile of an oxisol/latosol

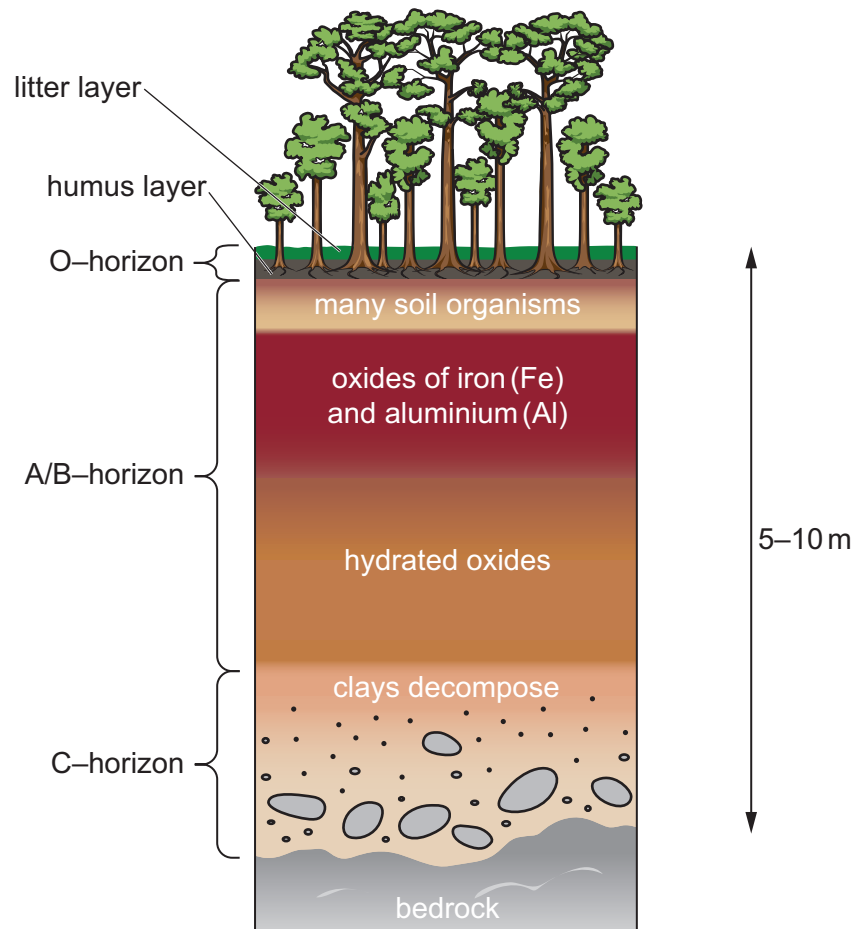

Rates of salt weathering near Prawle Point, Devon, UK, 1980–84

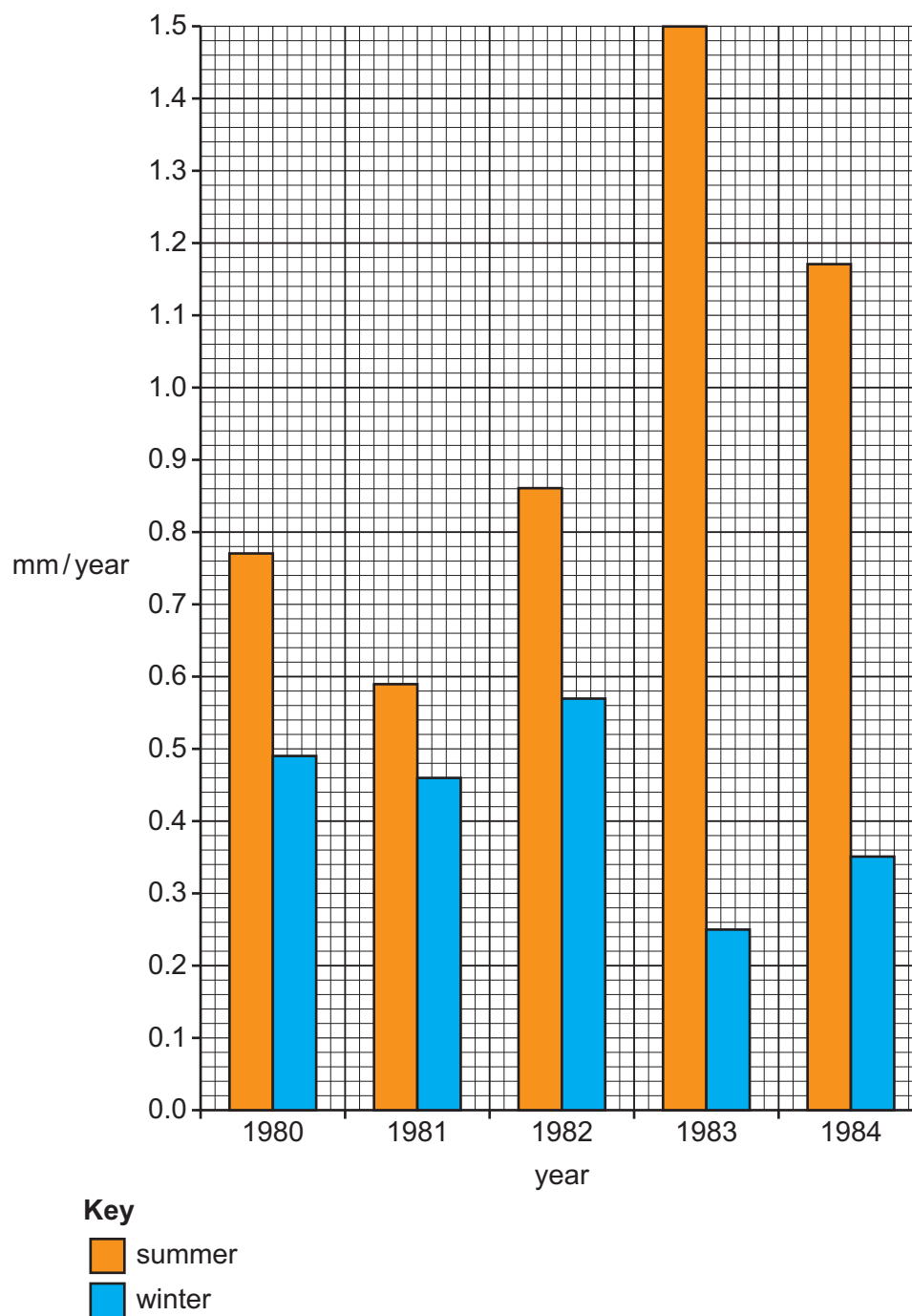
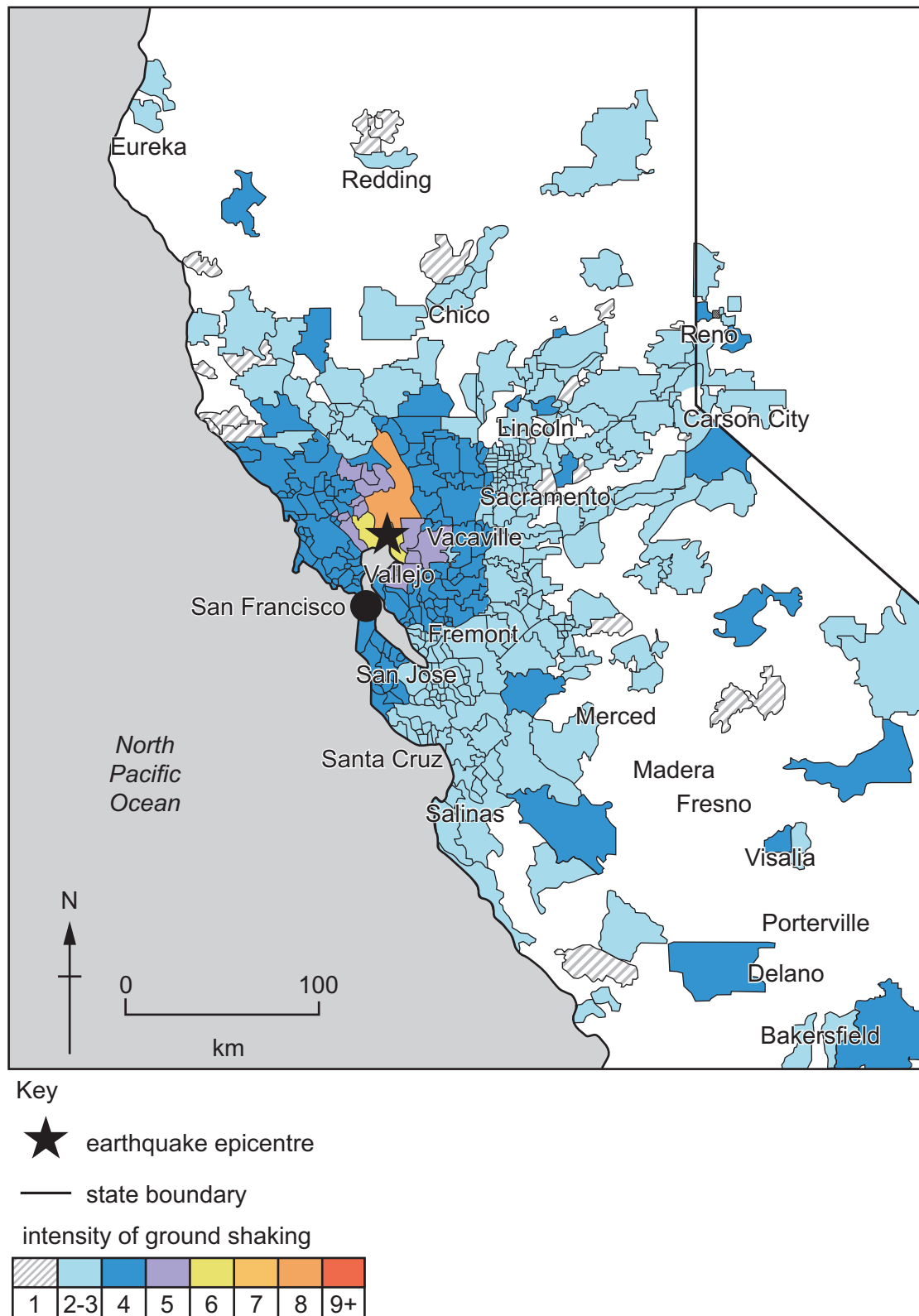

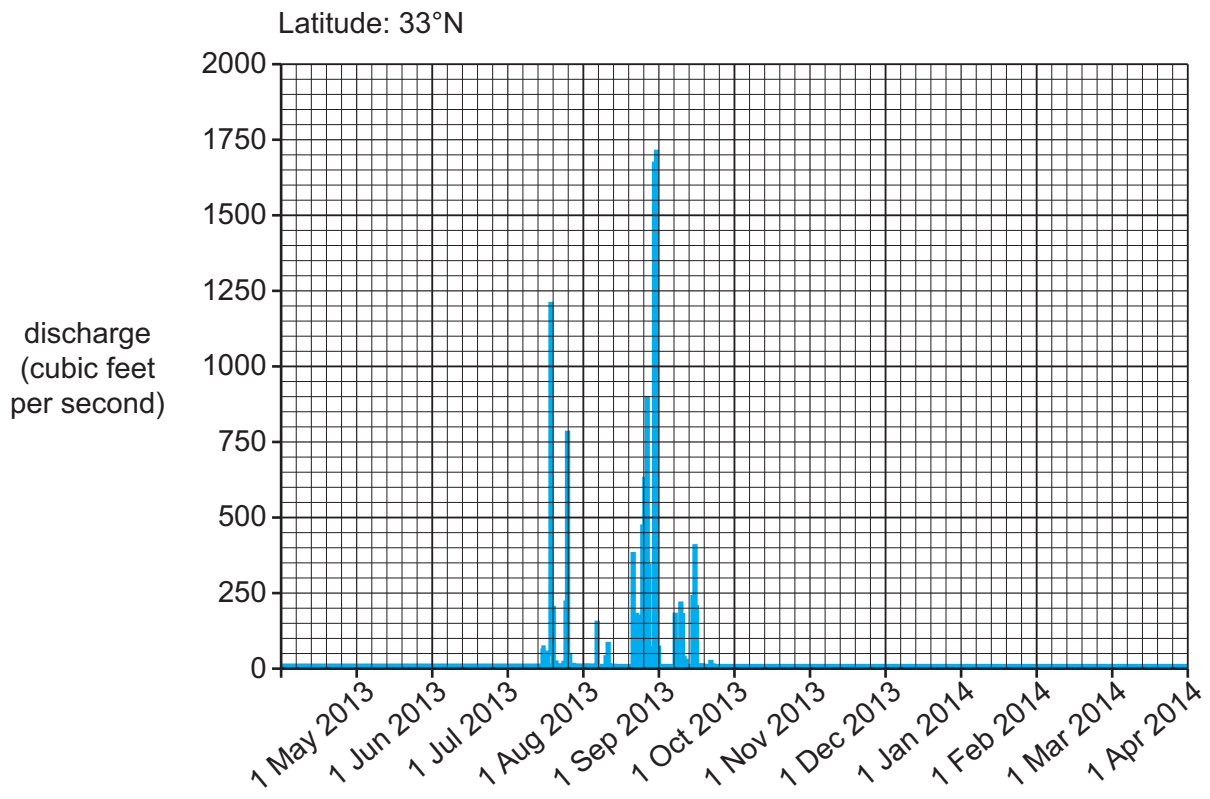
Reported* intensity of ground shaking produced by the 2014 South Napa earthquake, USA
