Percentage change in farm numbers and farm area by agricultural activity, in New Zealand, an HIC in Australasia, 2002–2016

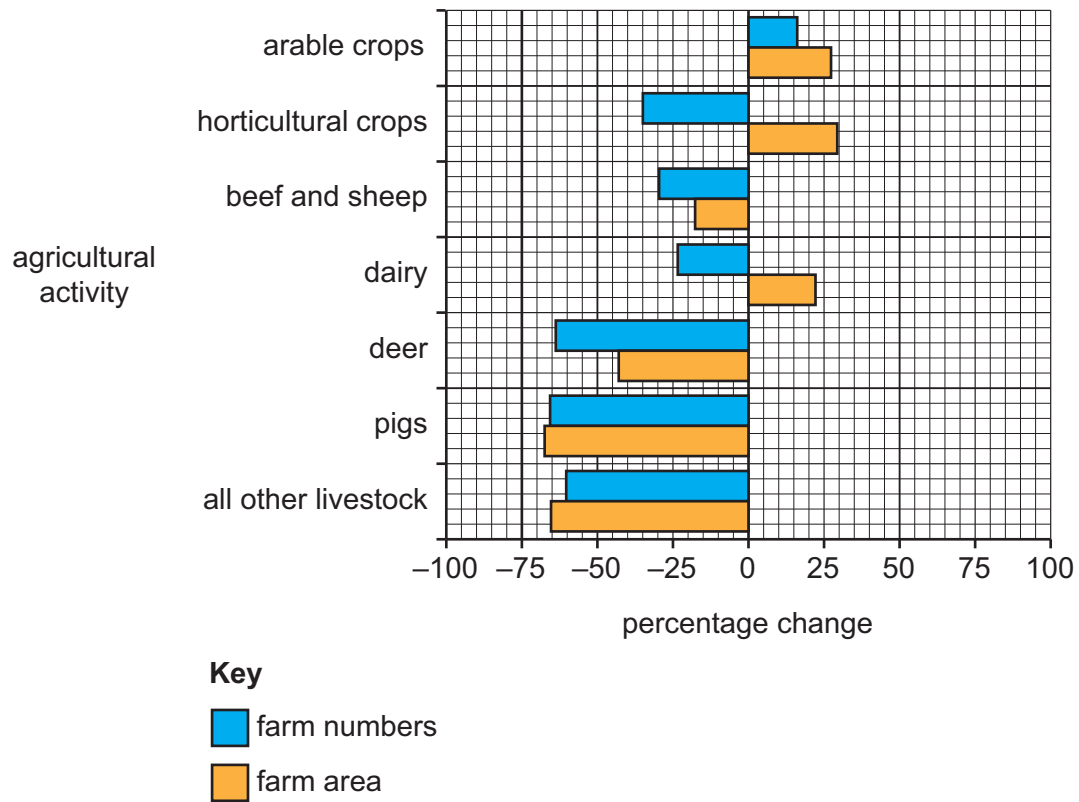
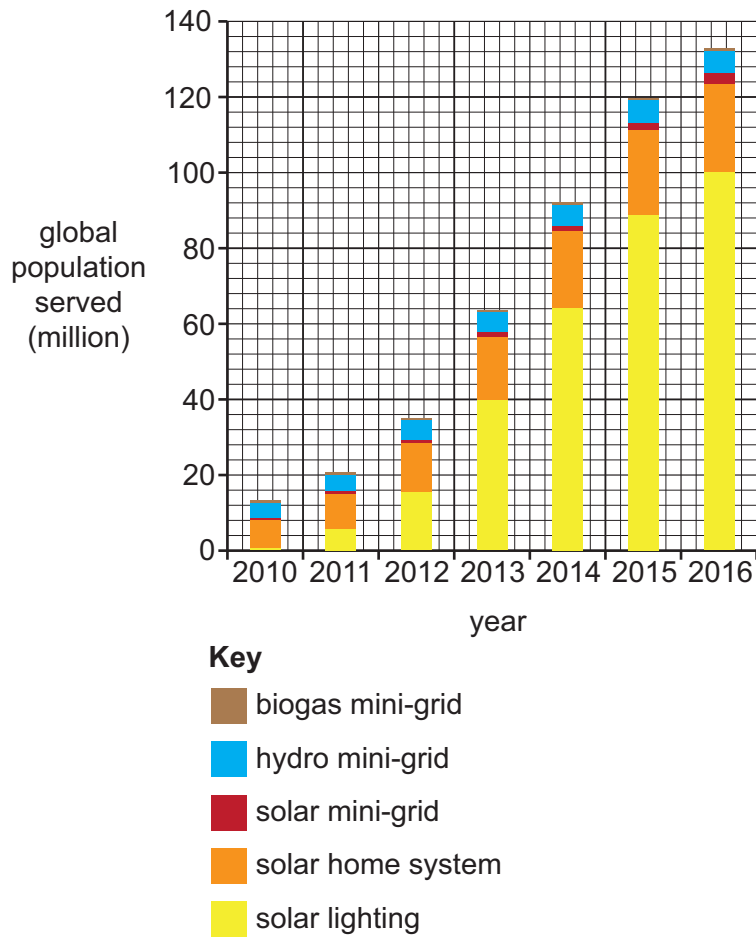

* a supply of electricity (often at a local scale) which is not connected to the national supply system

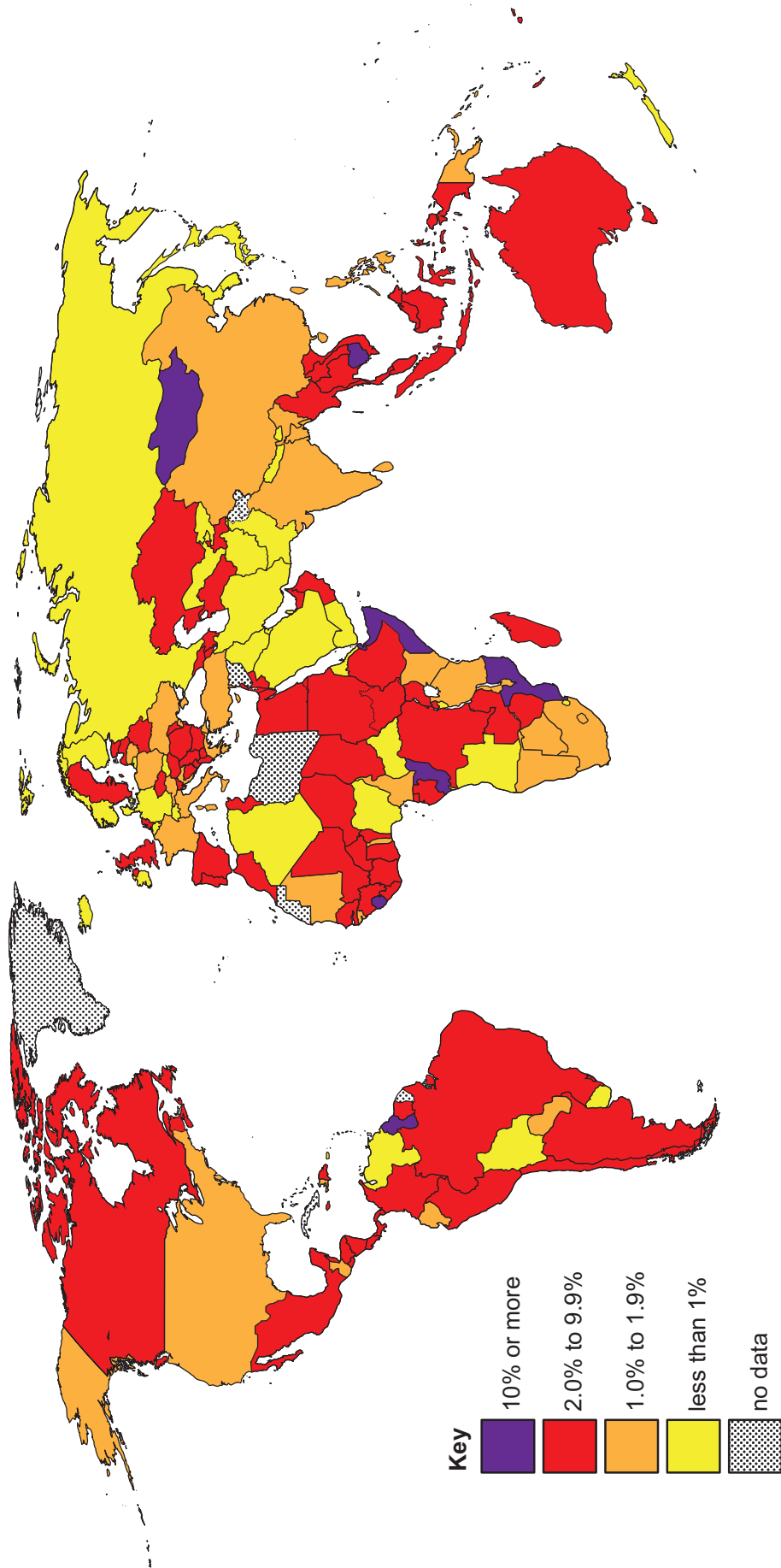
