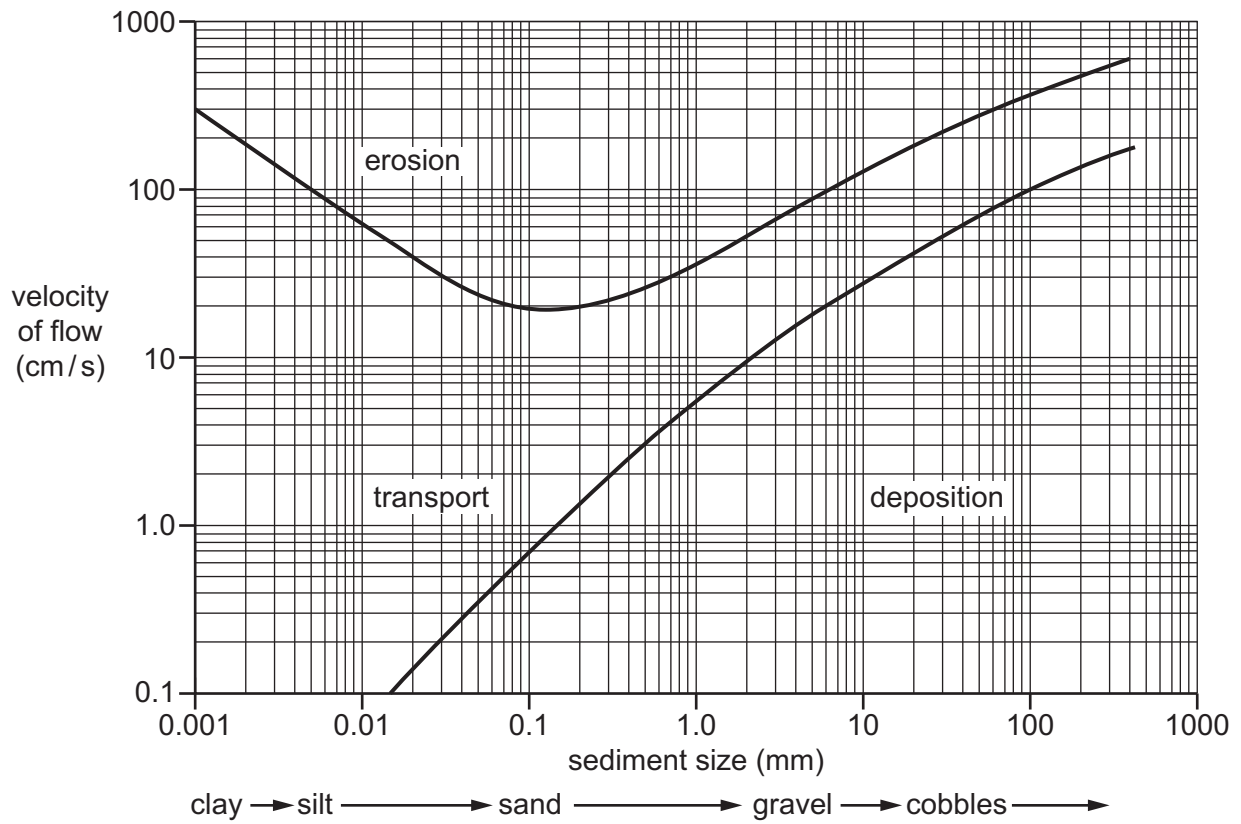

The state of water on two different surfaces on a winter day, in England, UK



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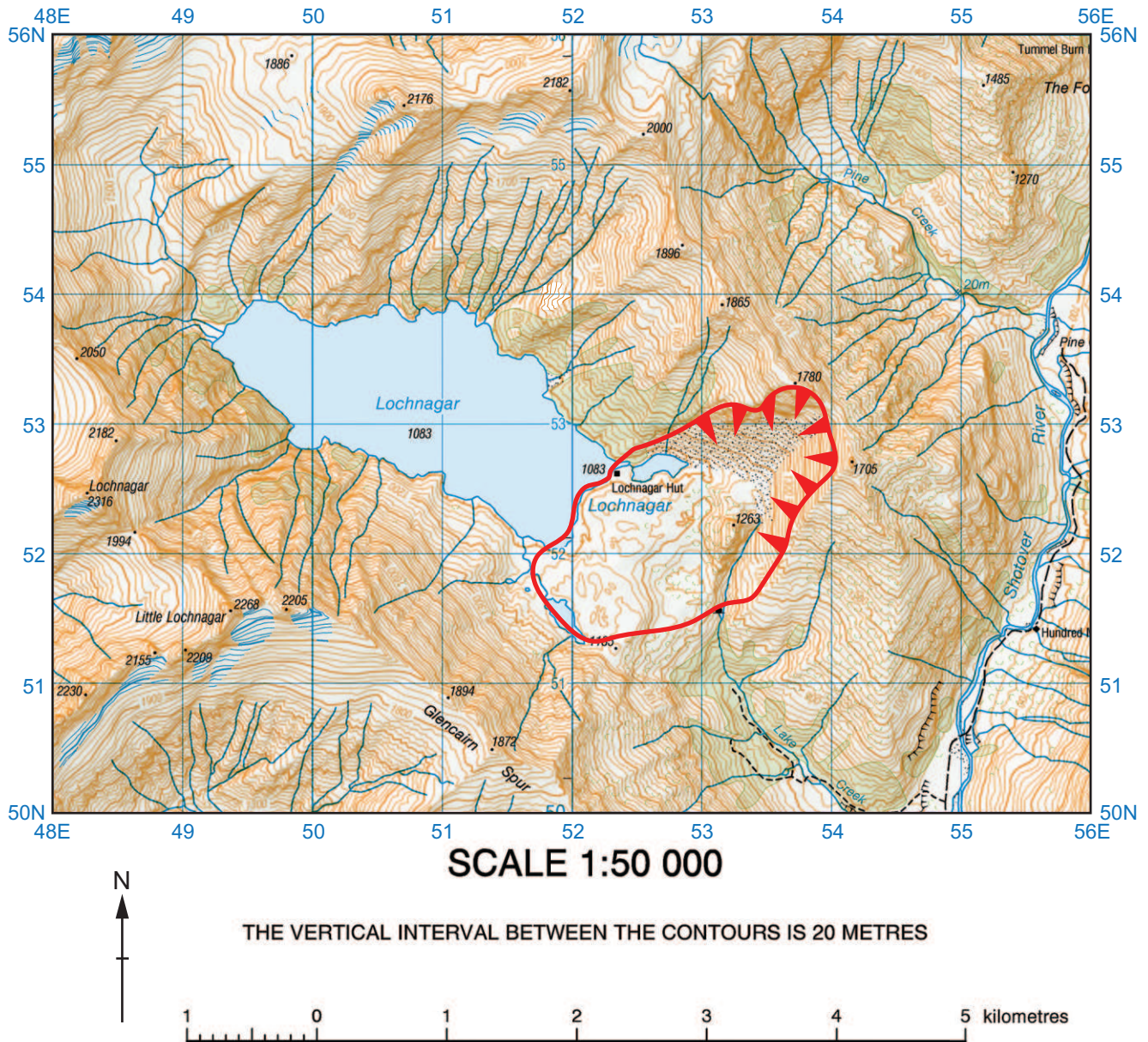
