A transect (A–B) showing the depth of weathered granite in northern Nigeria

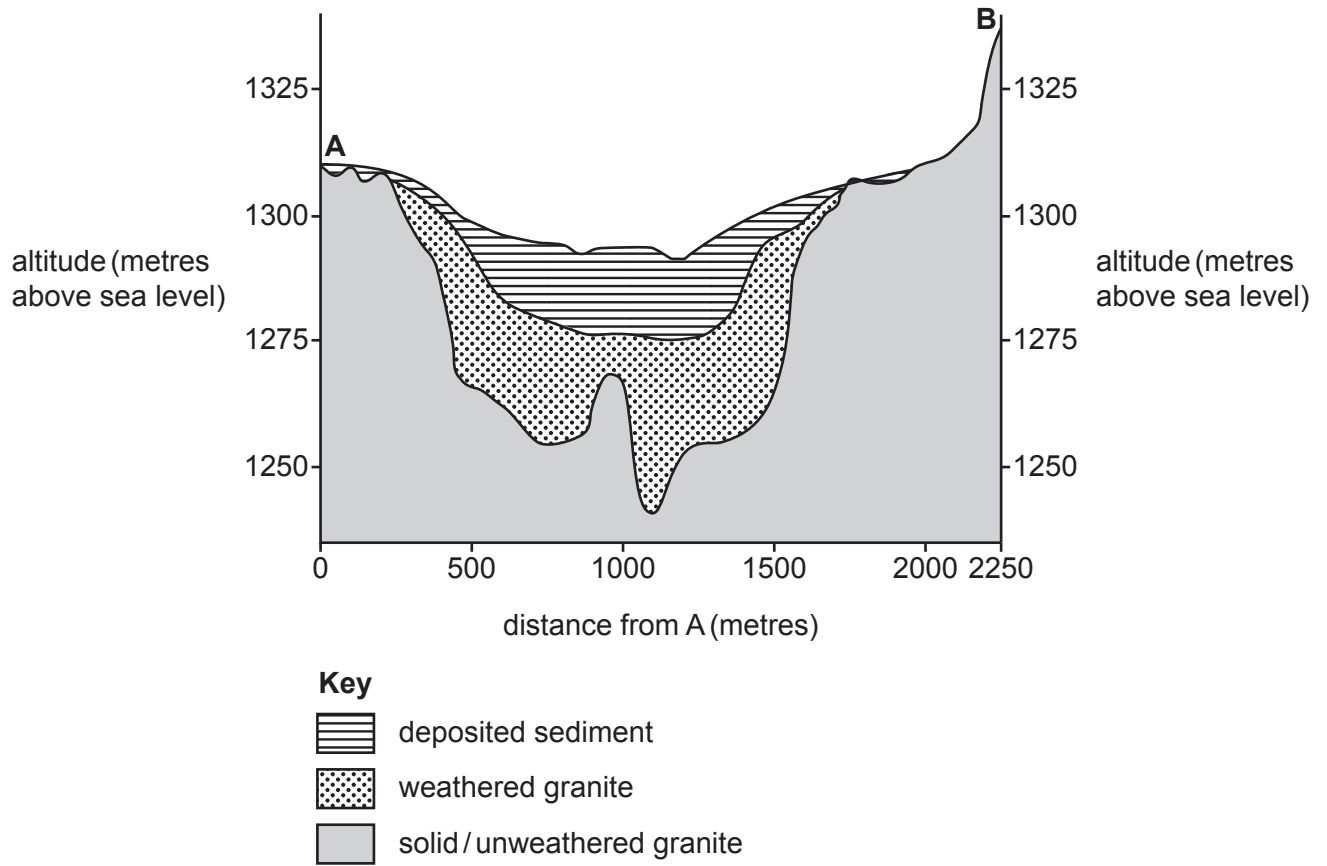

Changes to East Head spit, Sussex, UK, 1786–2005

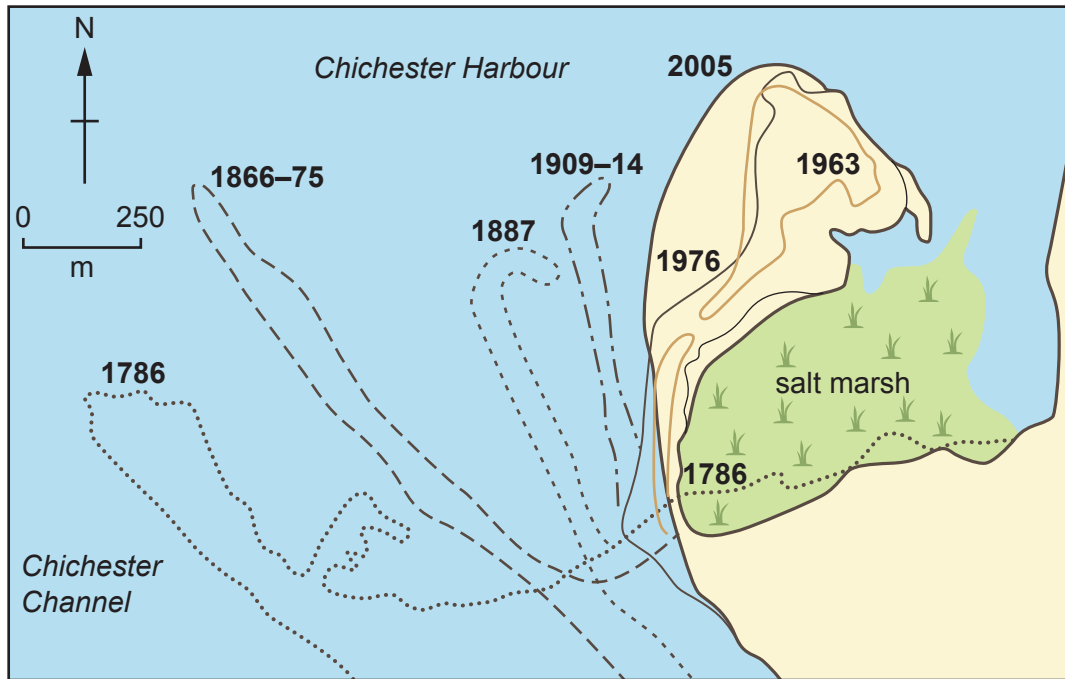

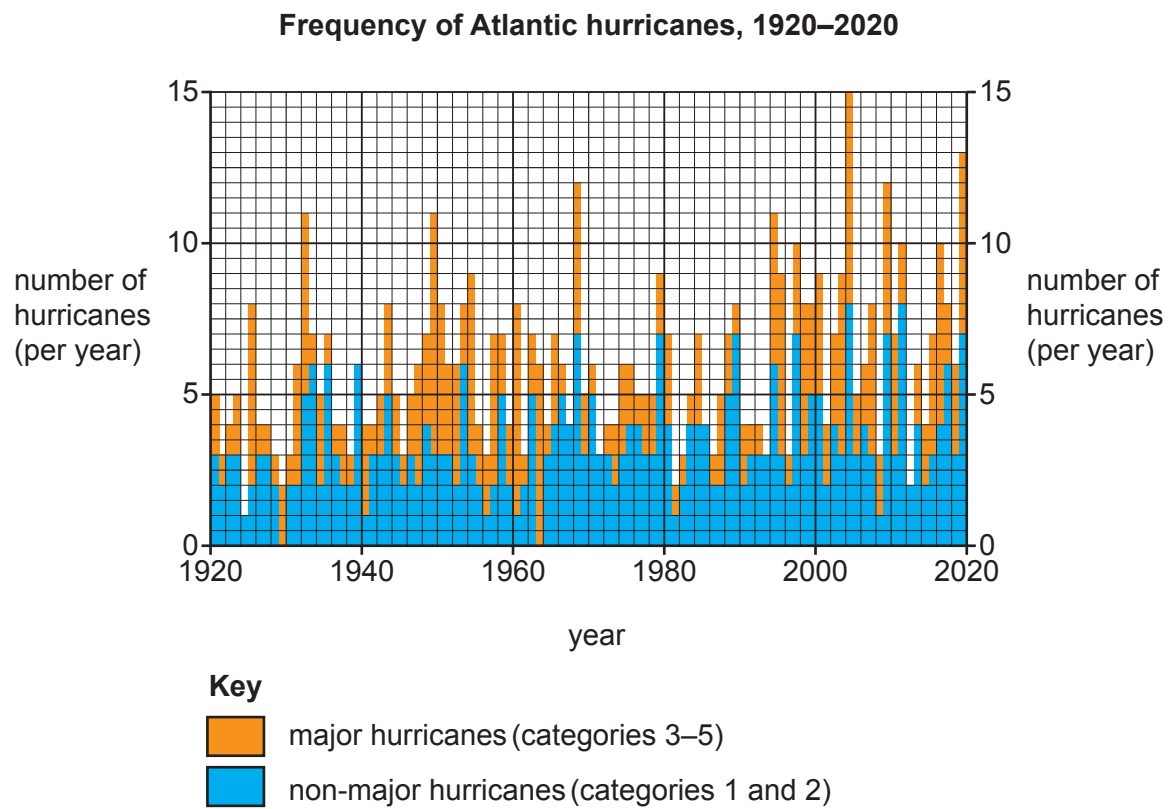
