



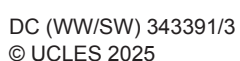

Percentage share of world trade for LICs/MICs and HICs, 2000–18

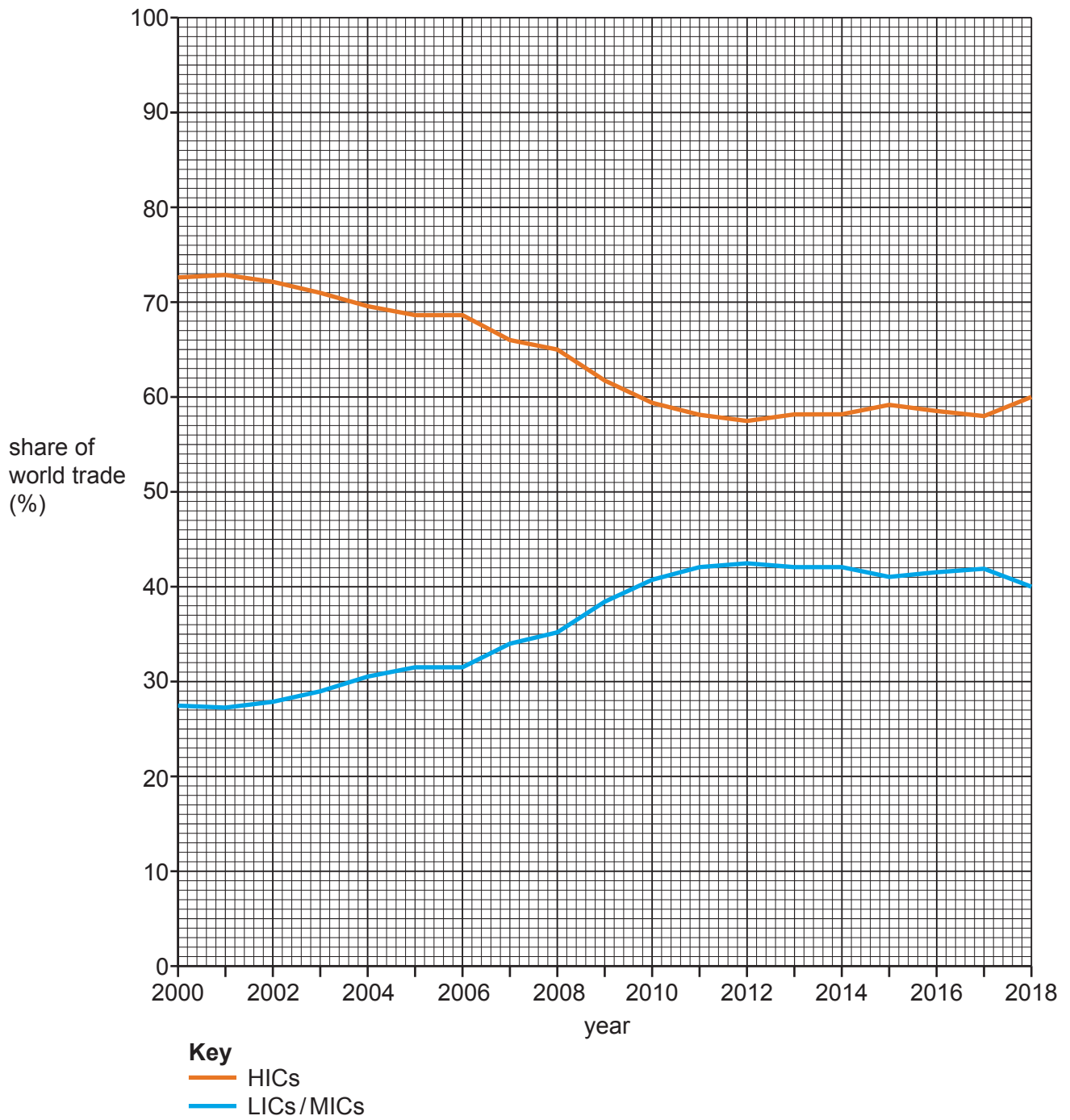
