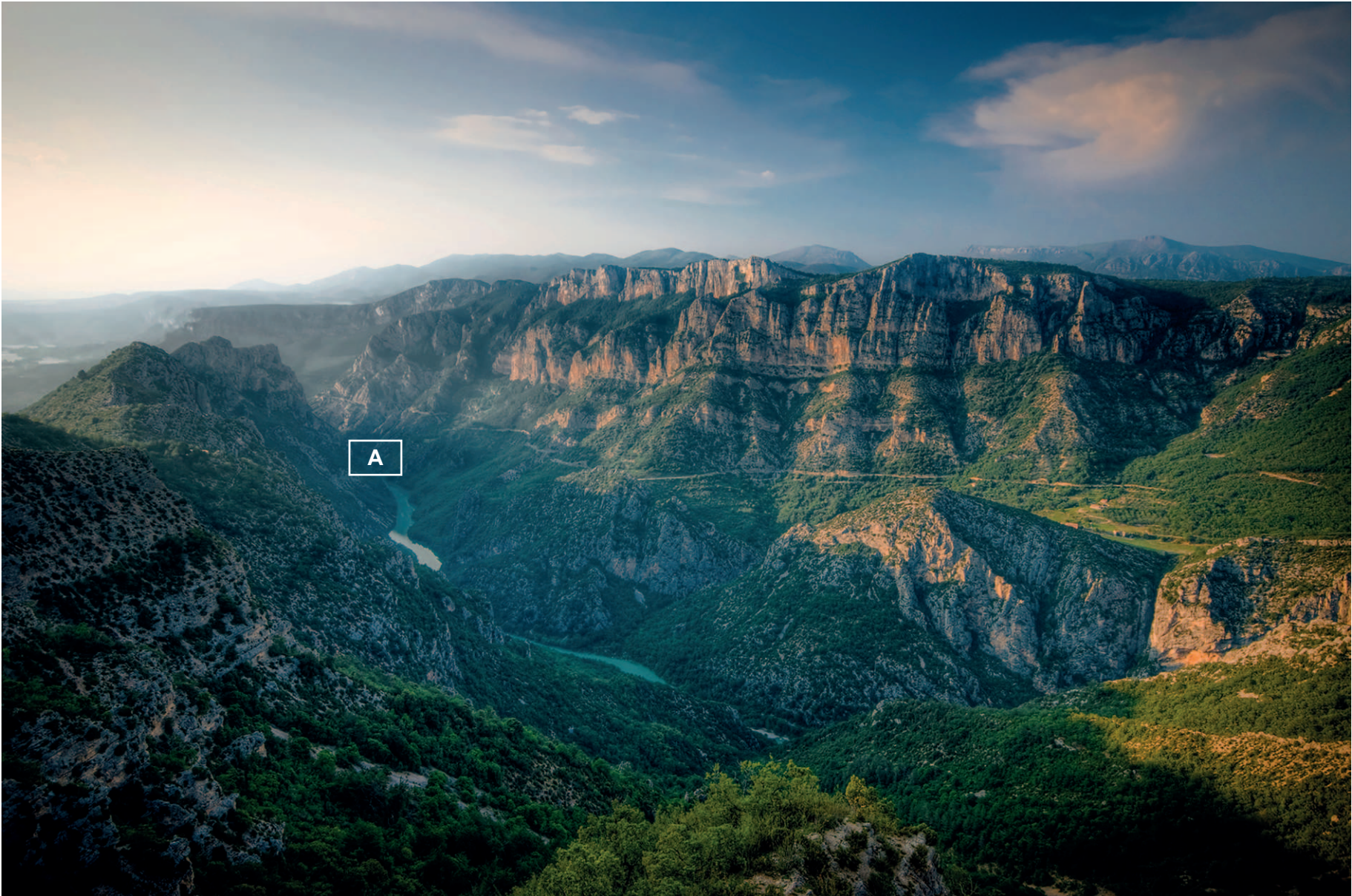
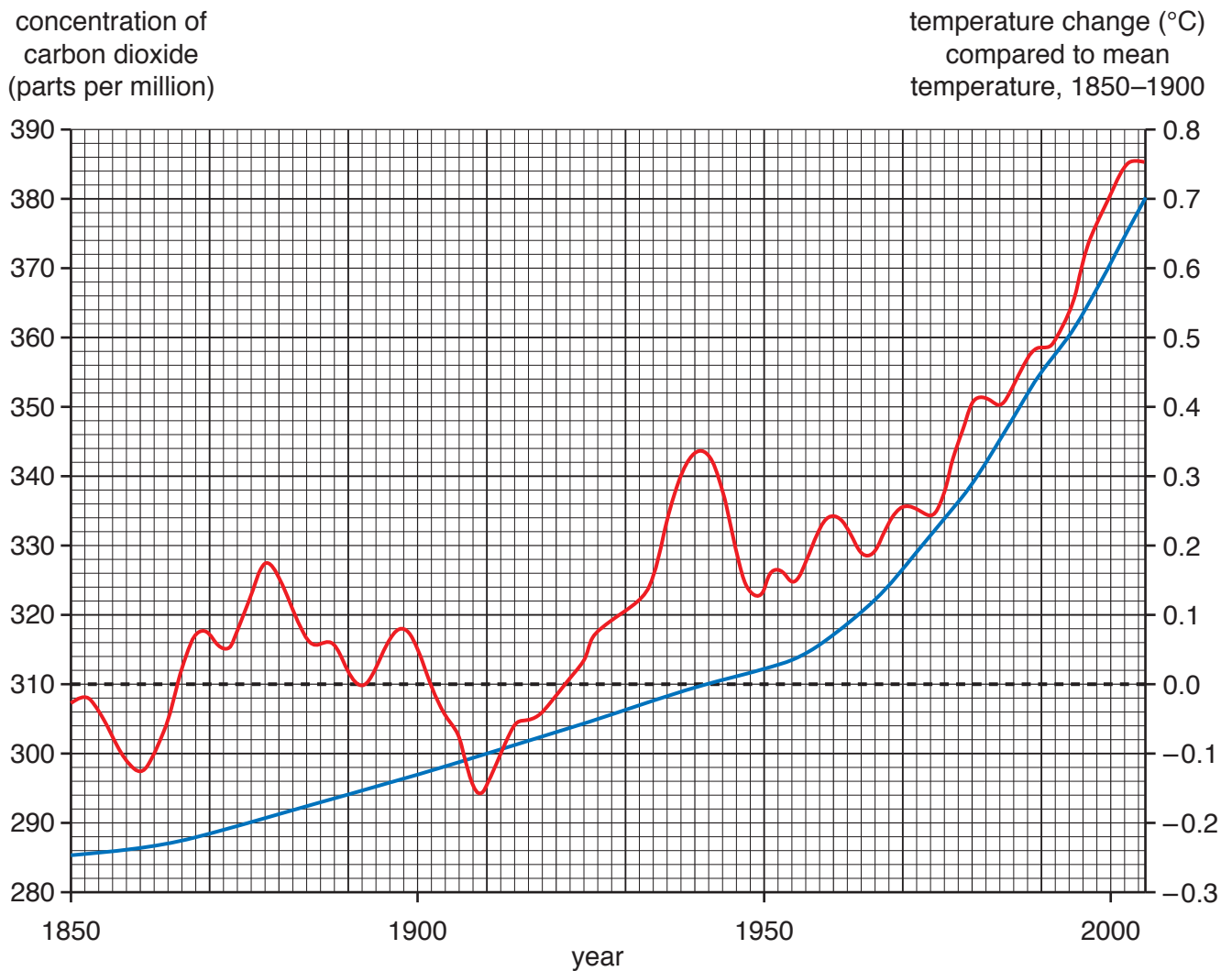

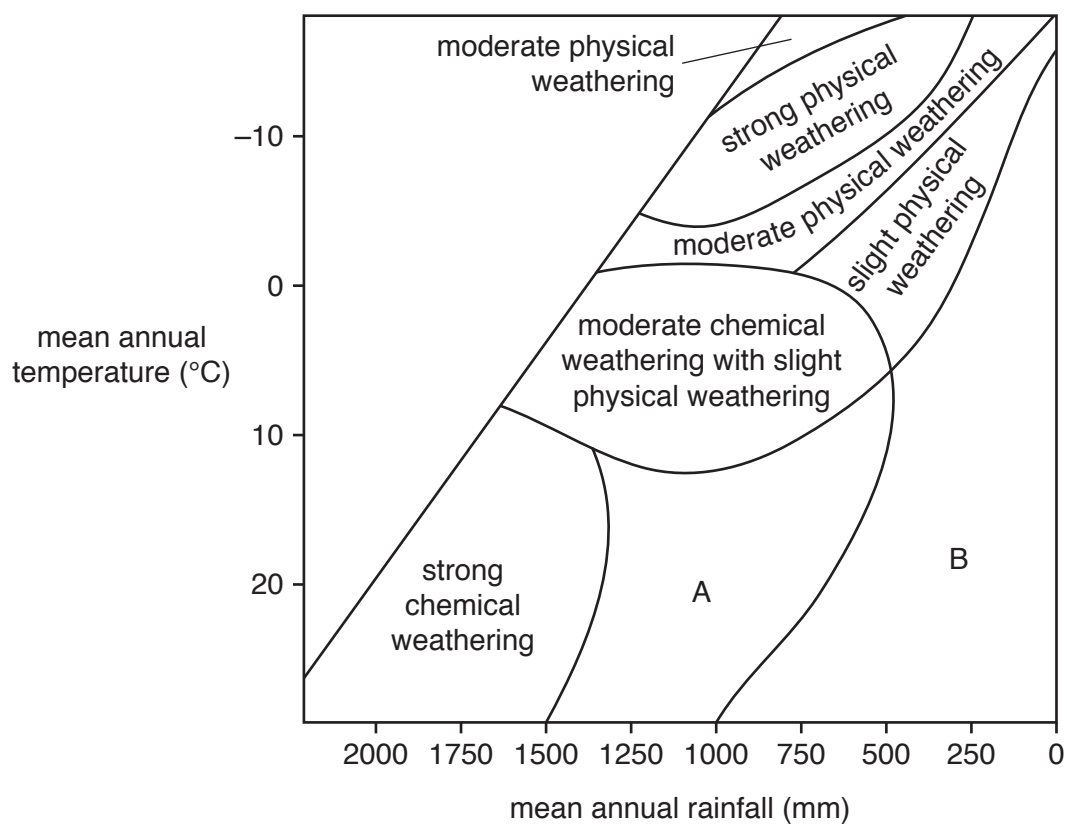
**Global temperature change and carbon dioxide concentration
