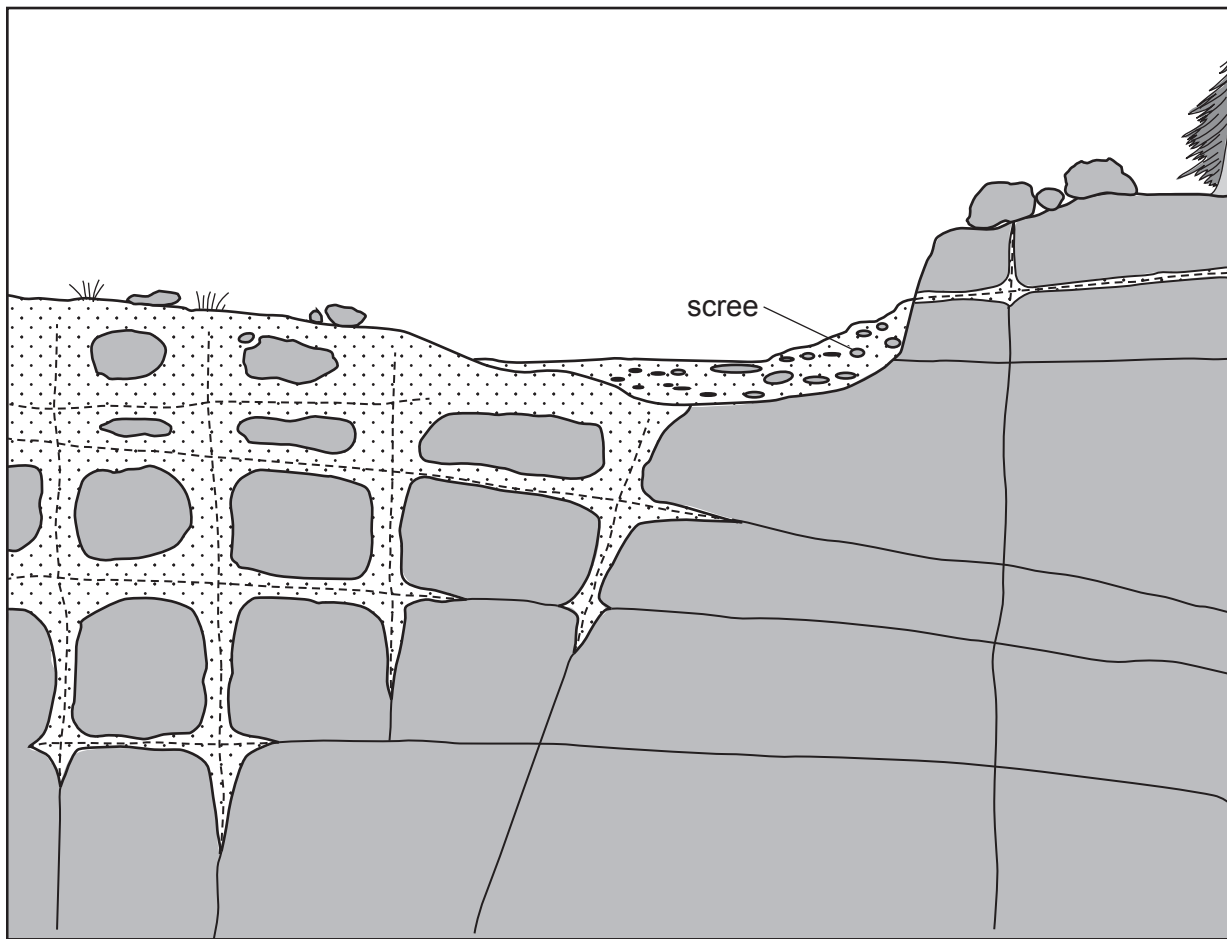

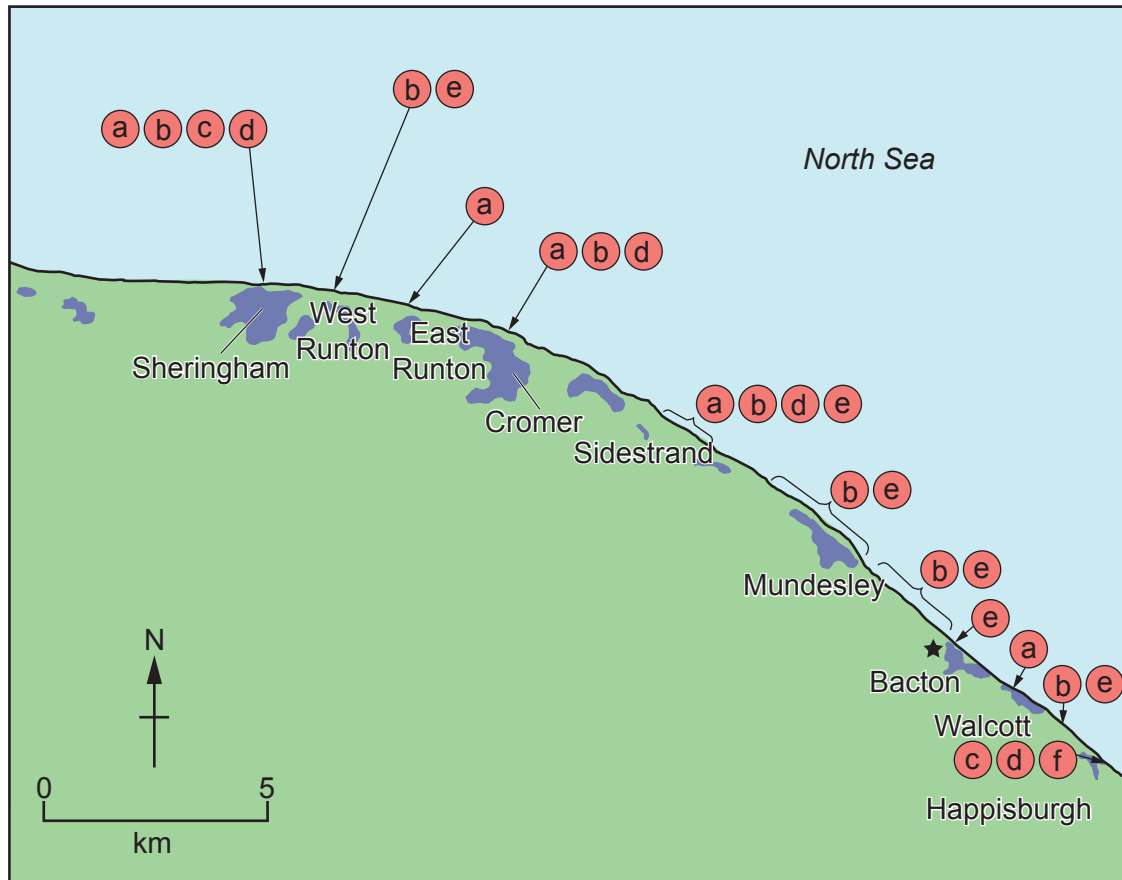

The global distribution of deaths from rainfall-triggered mass movement events, 2007–17

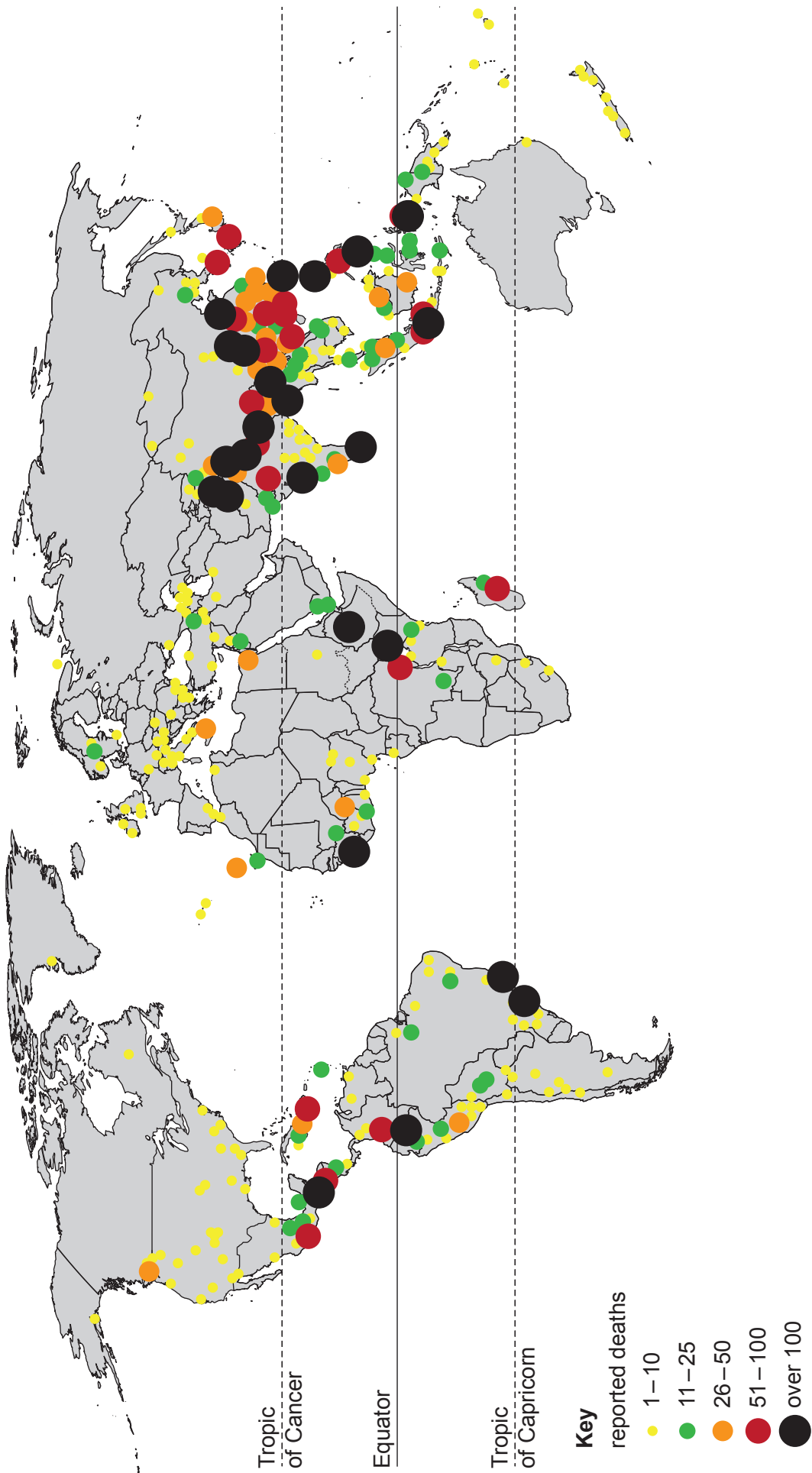
