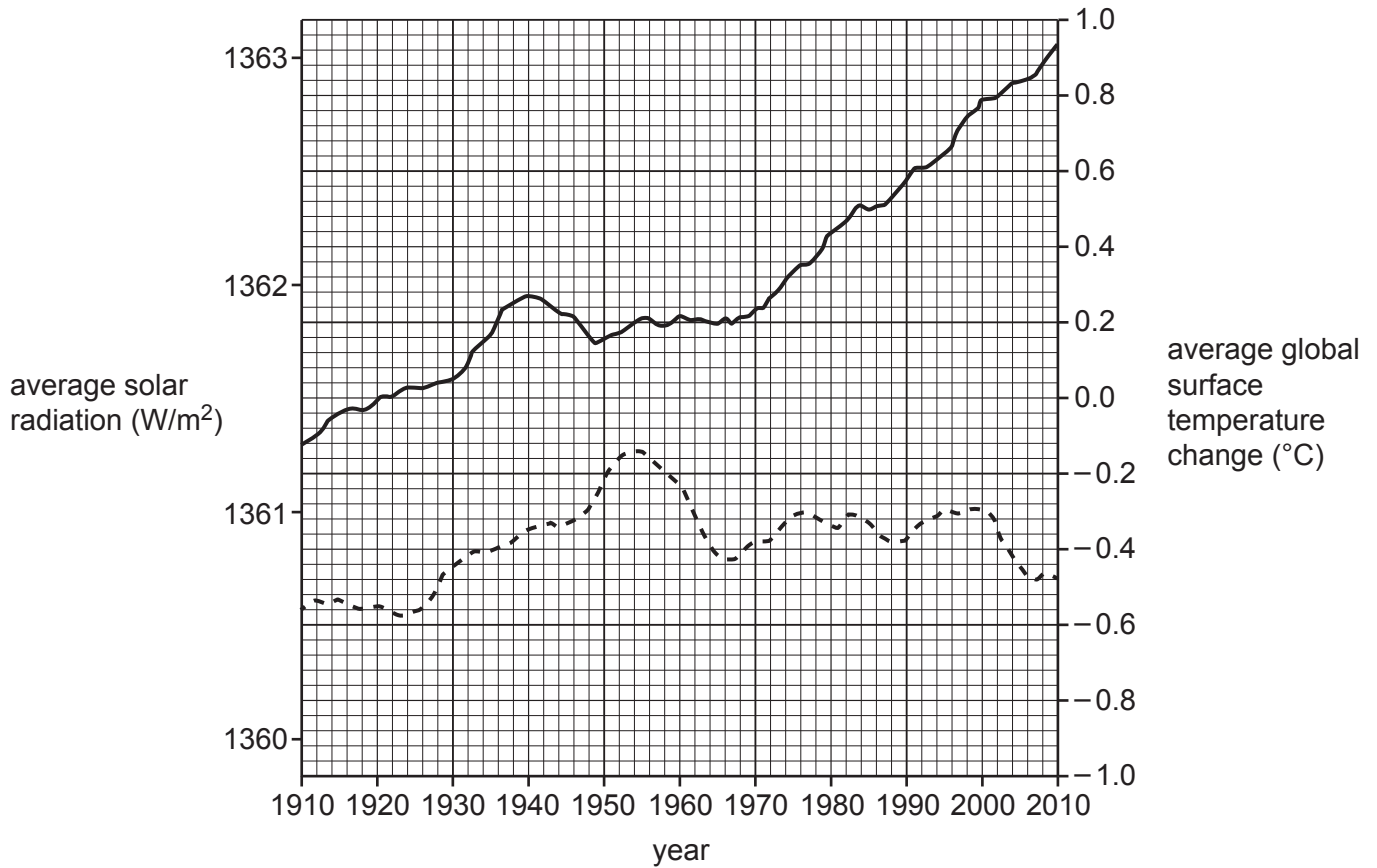

Tectonic landforms and processes at two types of convergent plate boundaries

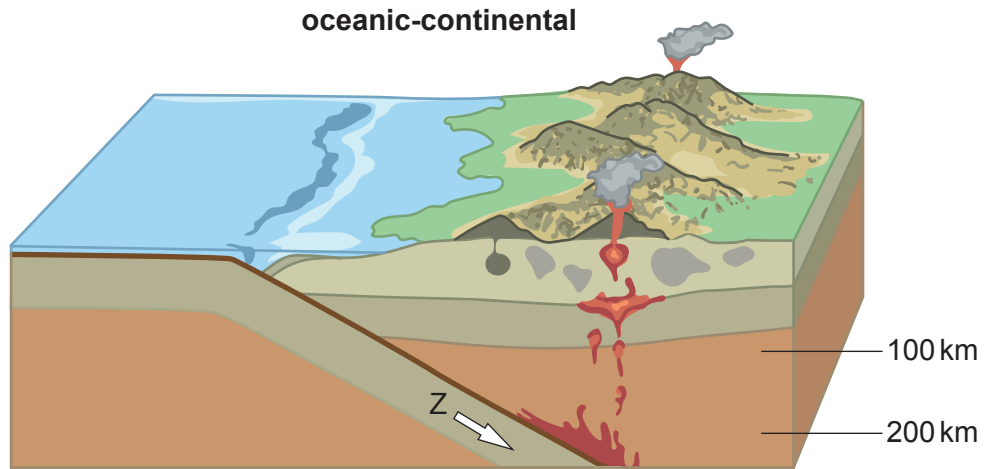

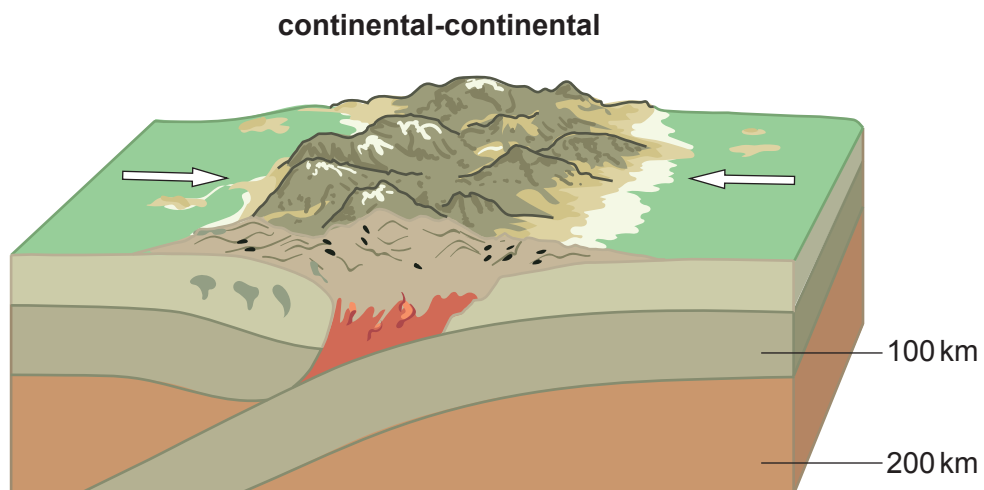
