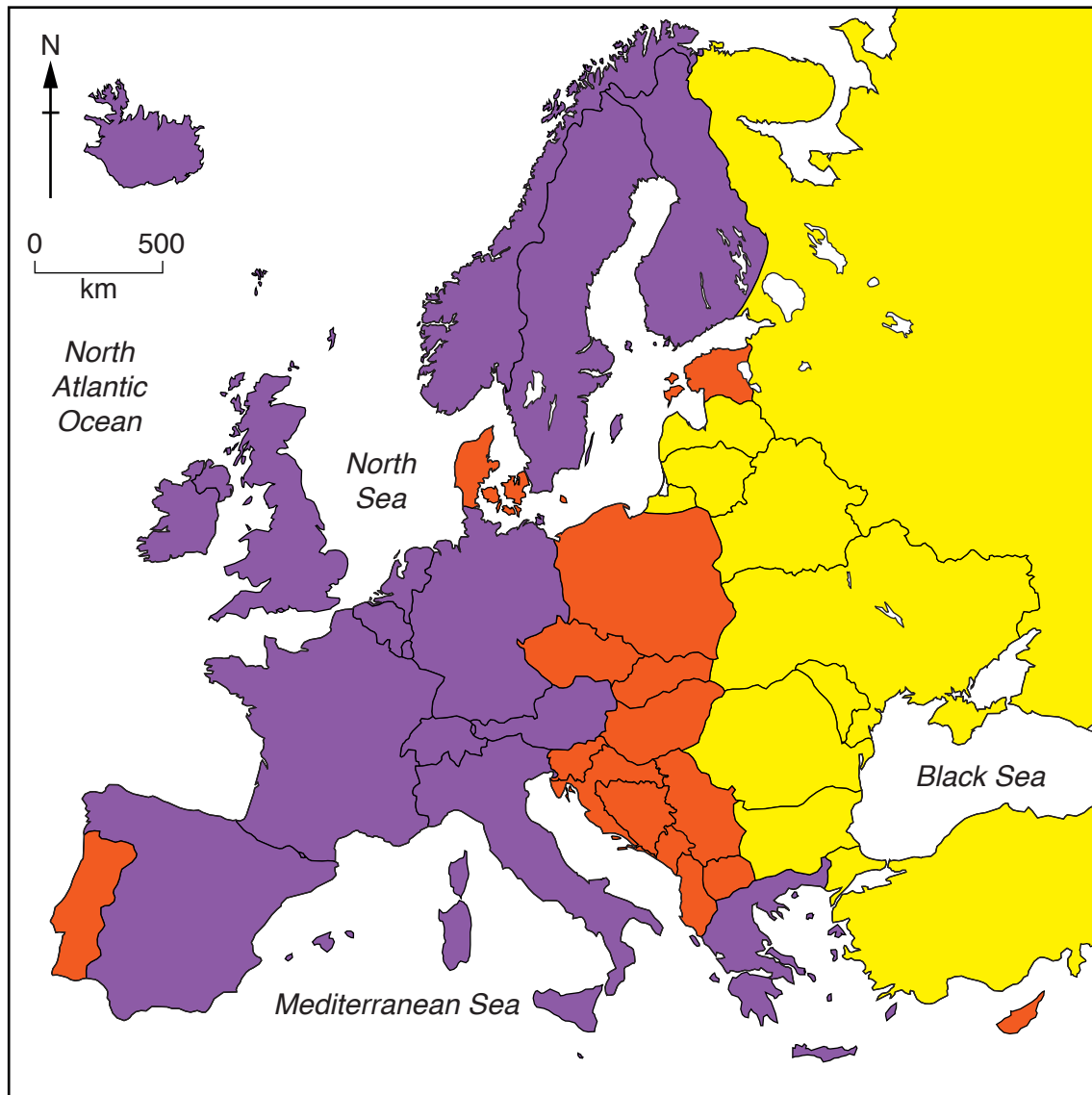

Number and percentage of world international migrants, 1980–2015

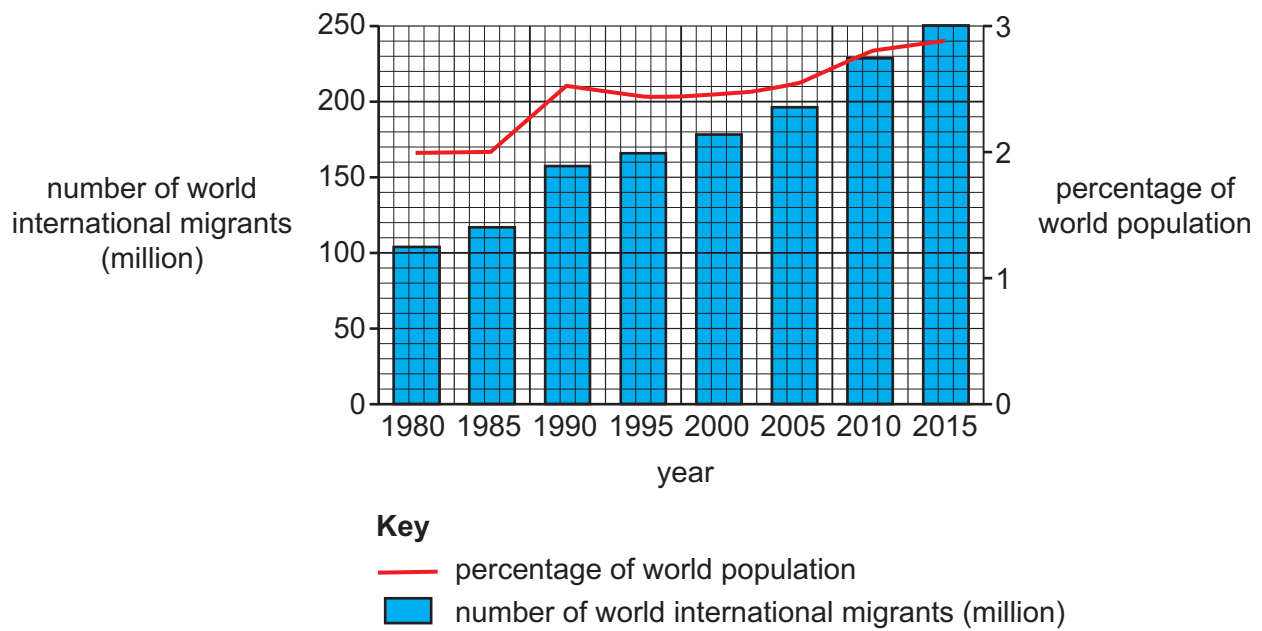
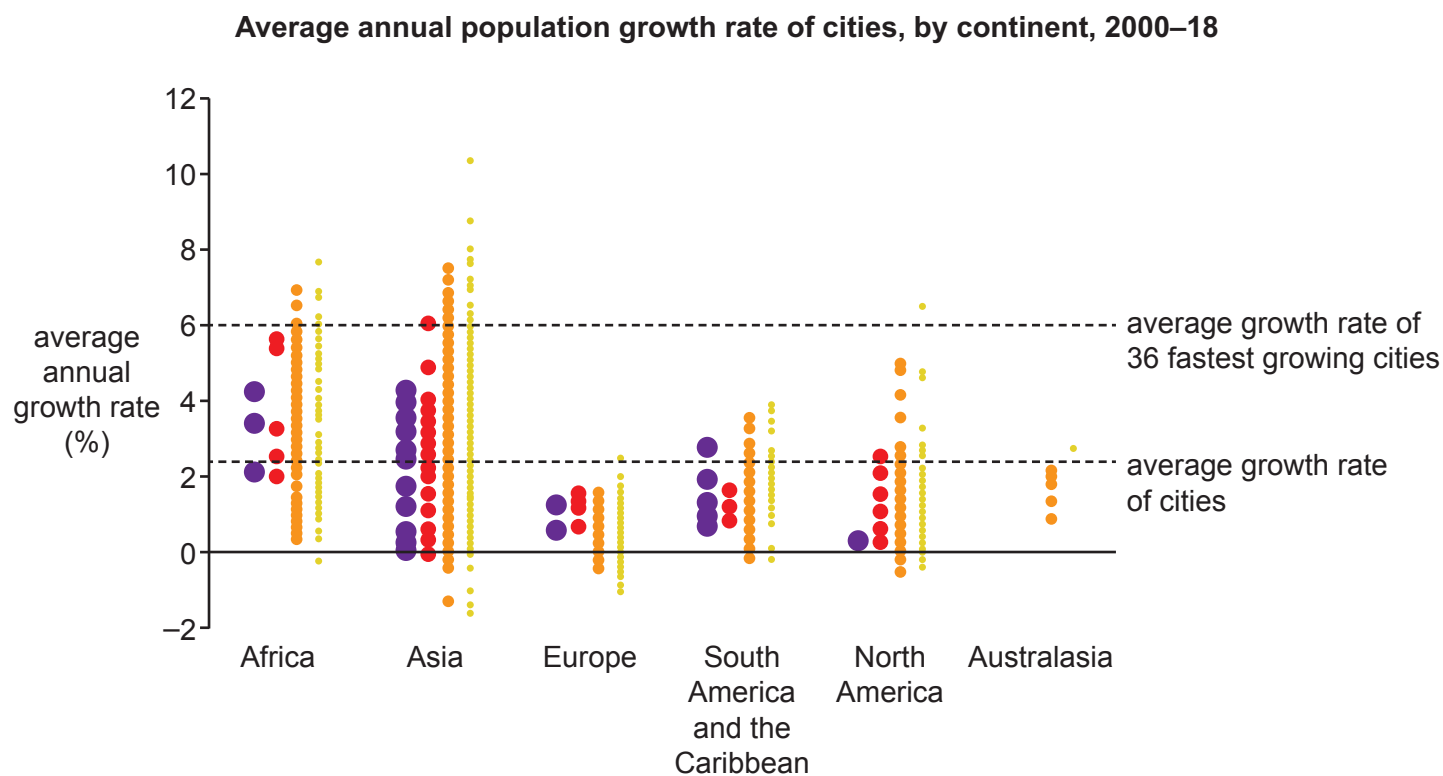
