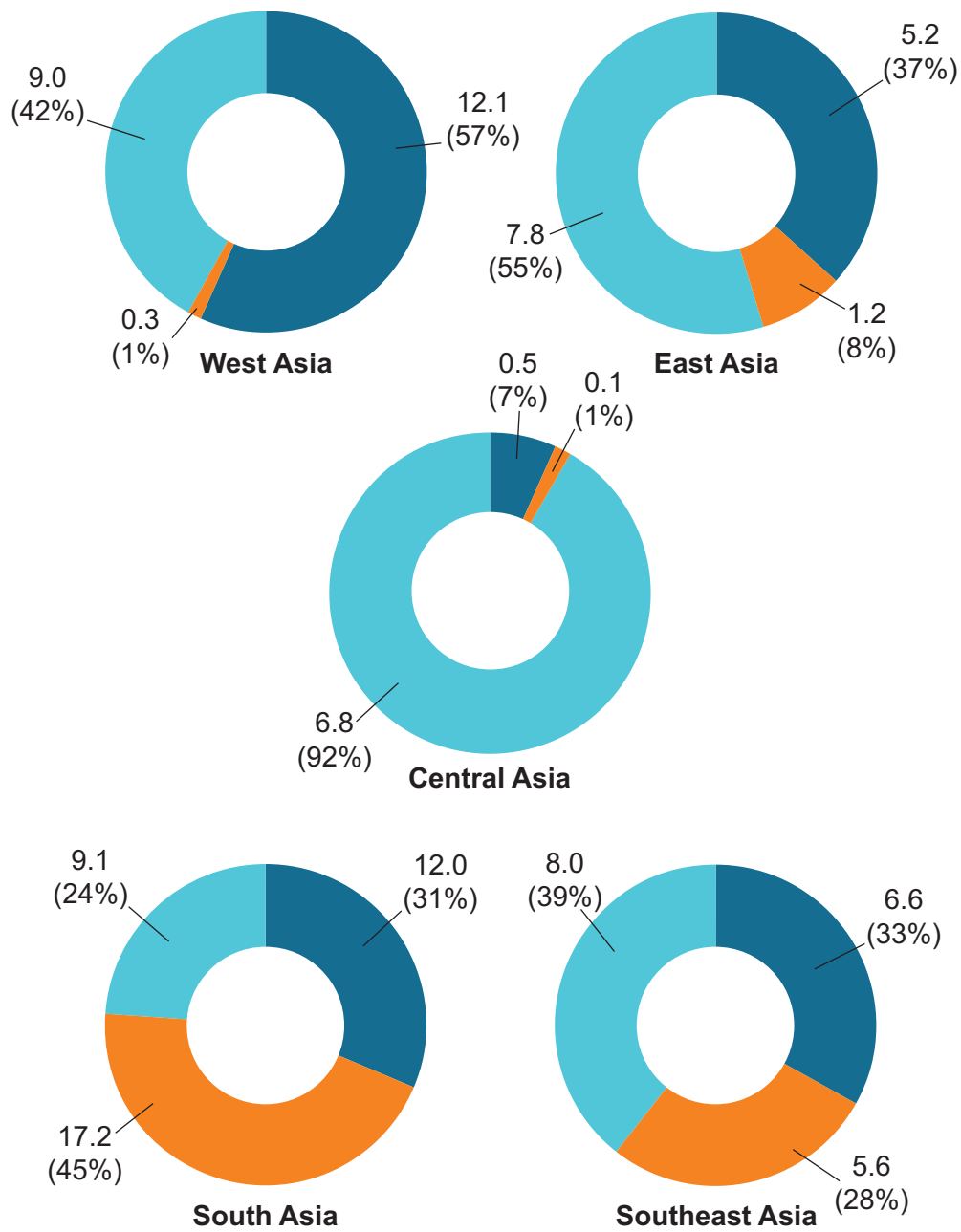

International migration for Asia, by sub-region, in 2015



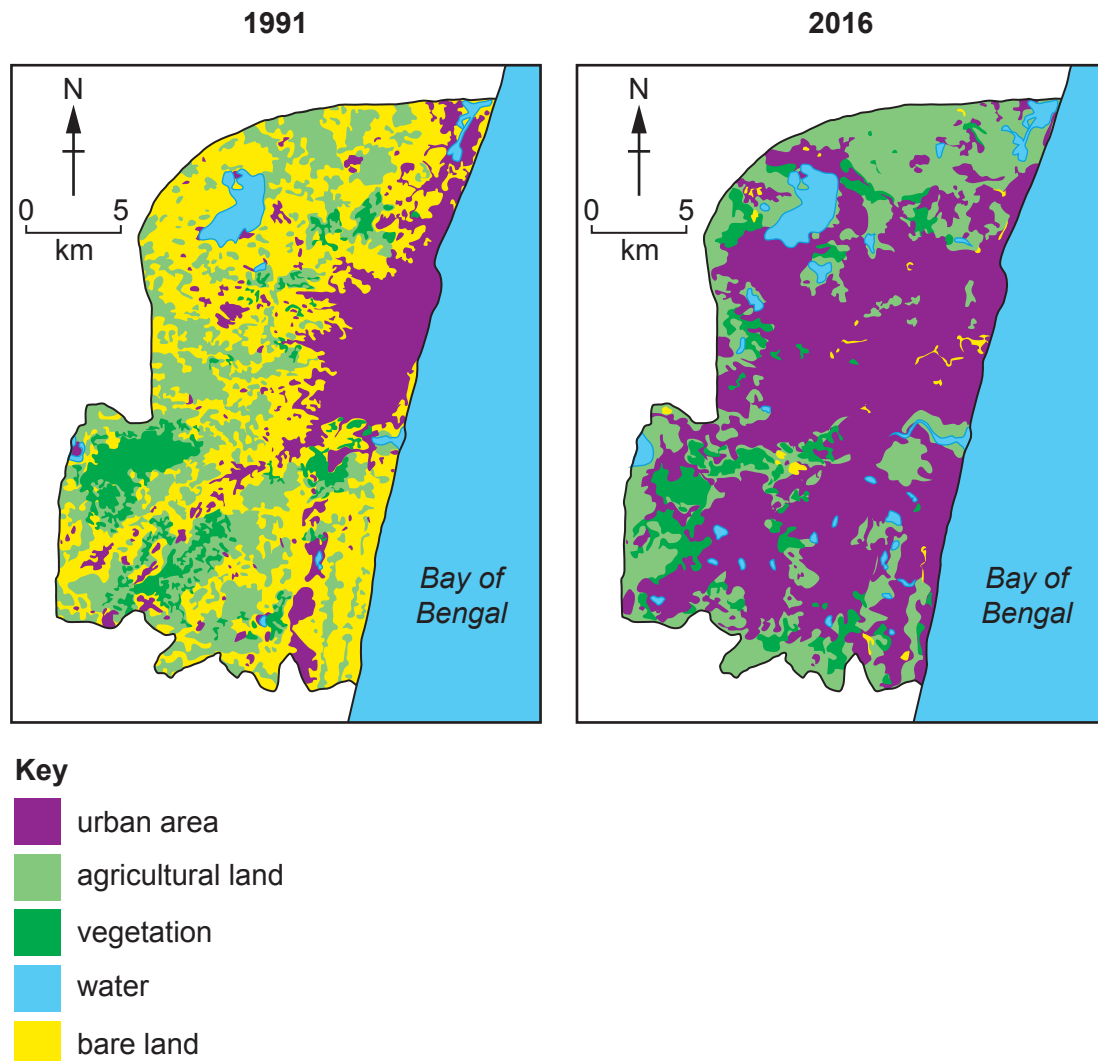
