River discharge and flood recurrence intervals for River Logone, Chad, Africa, 1 January 2021 to 1 October 2023

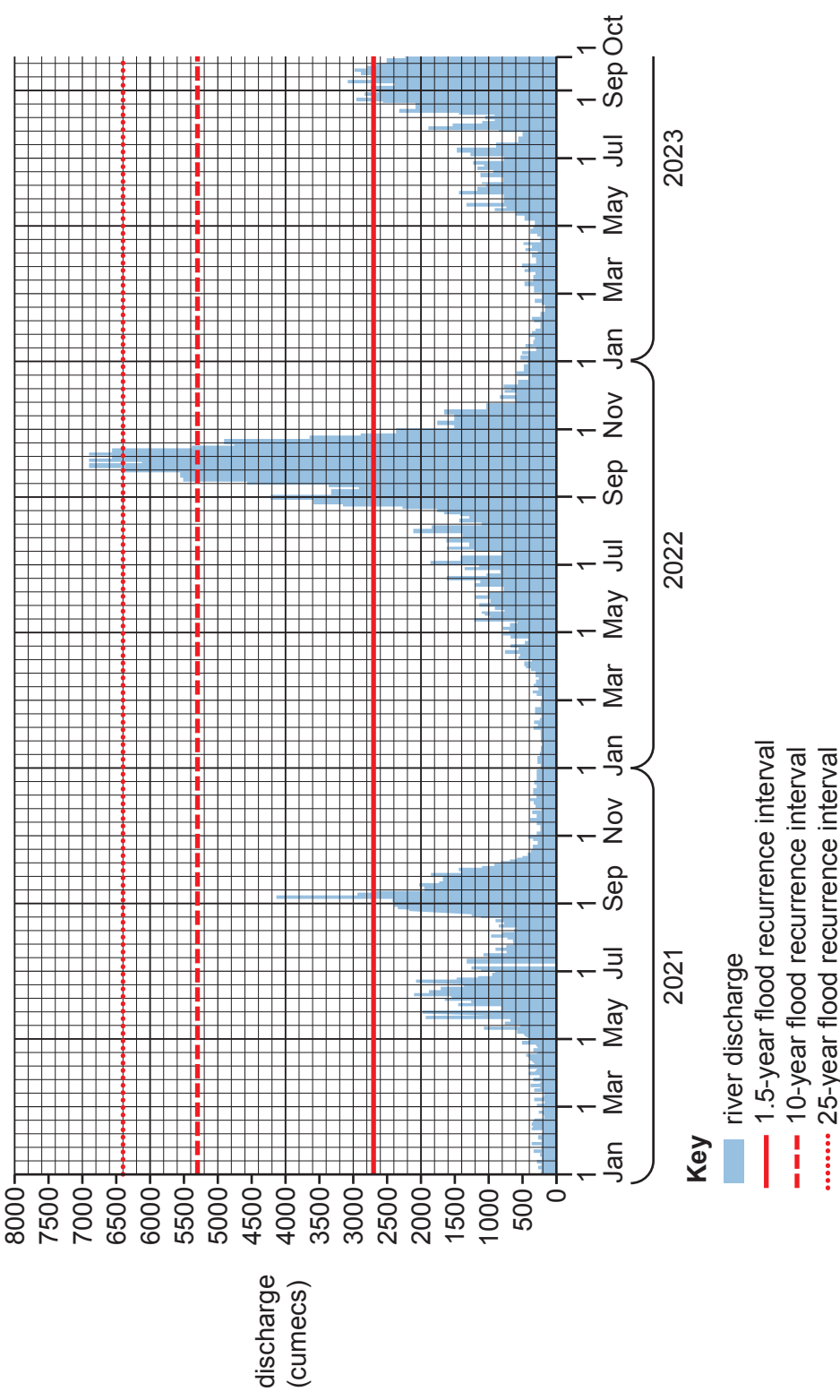

Differences in global average surface temperatures, 1880–2022, from the 1901–2000 average

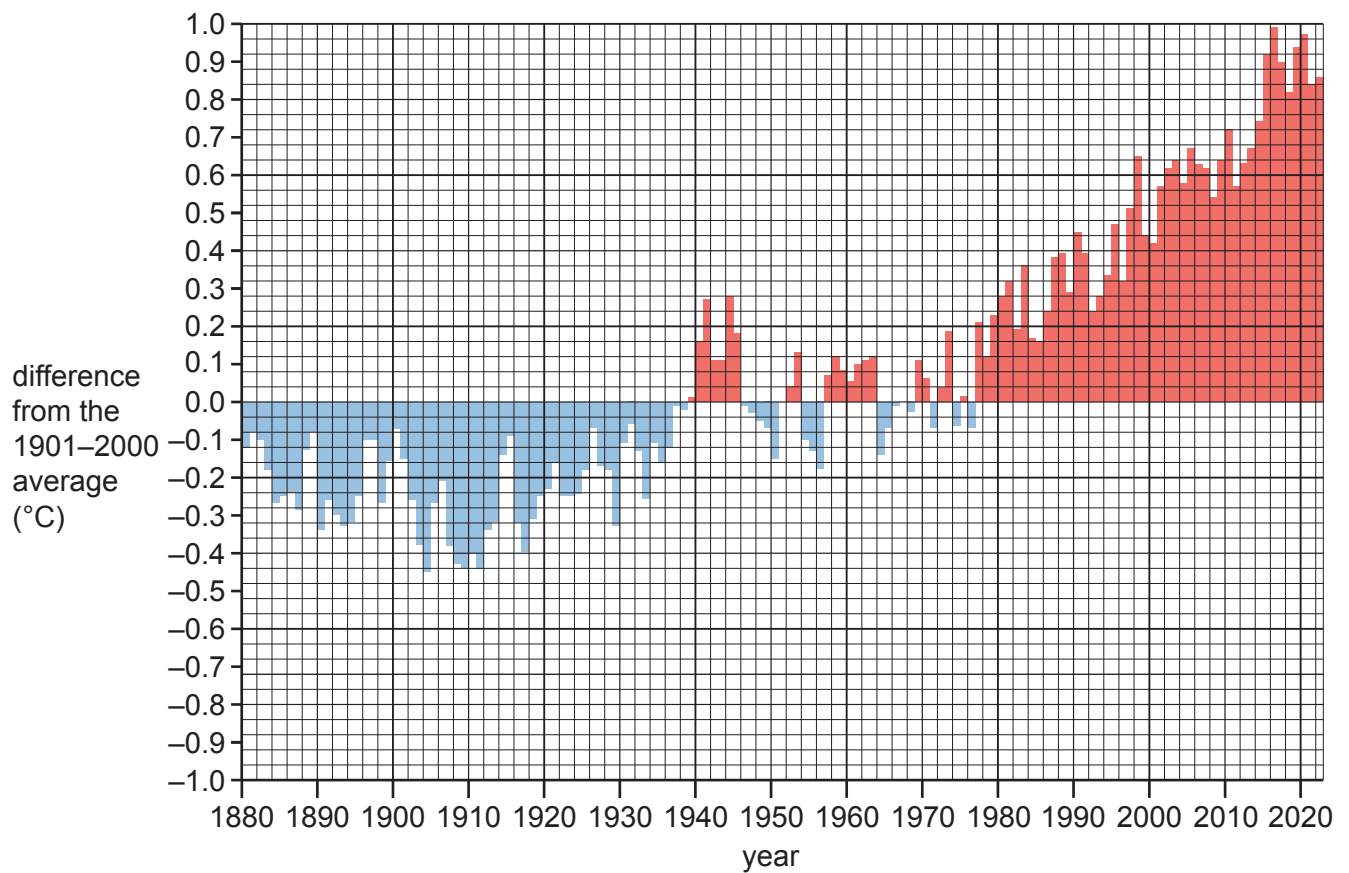
