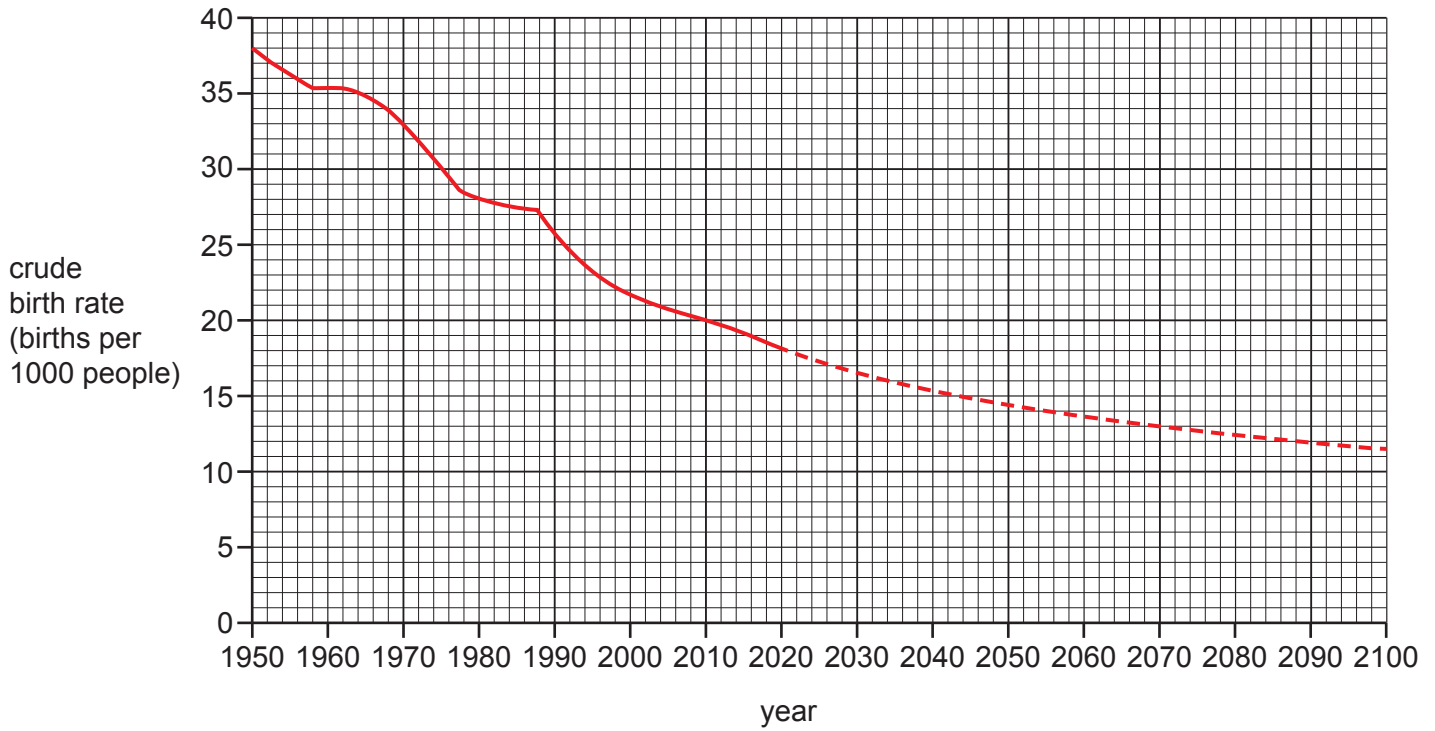

Number of international migrants in each continent, 1990–2020

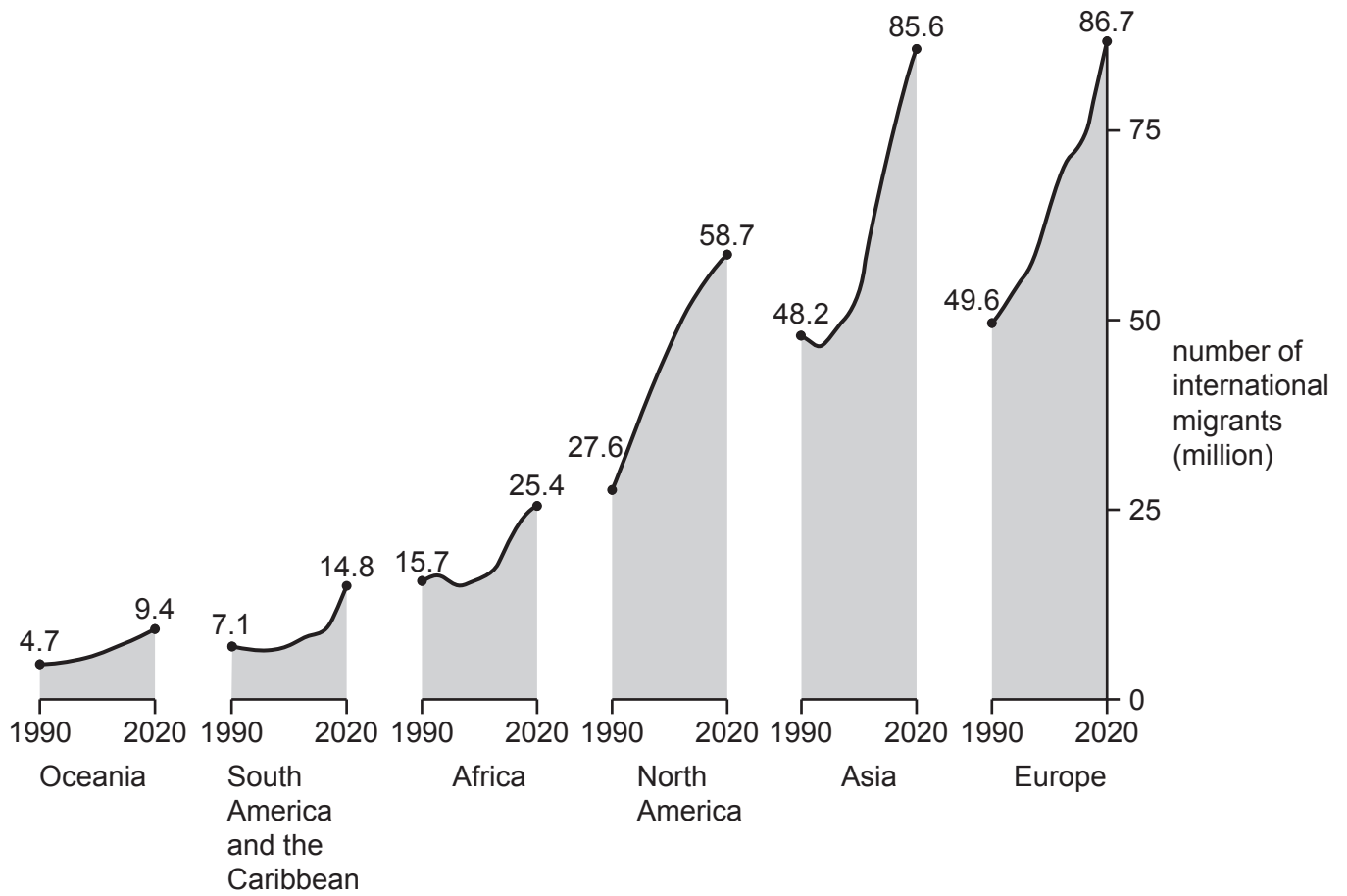
